### Evidence Building Community News

September 6 was the two year anniversary of the Commission on Evidence Based Policymaking report.

The [Census Longitudinal Infrastructure Project \(CLIP\)](#) is a collaborative effort to create an integrated set of linkable data files from the decennial Censuses, surveys, and administrative records held at the Census Bureau for research.

### **1940 Census Research**

One of the goals of CLIP is to create linkages between modern datasets and the 1940 Census microdata file. Census researchers have been working on creating a linkage using the Person Identification Validation System (PVS) probabilistic matching system. The addition of the 1940 Census will greatly enhance the capabilities of CLIP. A working paper on methodology and results is forthcoming in December.

### **New Working Paper**

A working paper on one of the CLIP pilot projects, Gentrification and Neighborhood Change is now available:

*The Effects of Gentrification on the Well-Being and Opportunity of Original Resident Adults and Children*

Quentin Brummet and Davin Reed

This paper uses new longitudinal census microdata to provide the first causal evidence of how gentrification affects a broad set of outcomes for original resident adults and children.
