2020 Census Enumeration at Transitory Locations Bottom Line Up Front (BLUF)

As of September 2, 2020

- Transitory Locations Advance Contact (TLAC) workload: 199,961
- Enumeration at Transitory Locations (ETL) initial workload: 61,853
- Enumeration at Transitory Locations data collection begins 8/31 - 9/28 – begun!

Training

- ETL Clerical training started 8/17 – completed!
- ETL Enumerator Training started 8/24 – completed!

ETL Overall Response Rate: 9.93%; Current Workload: 62,088

Background: 2020 Census Enumeration At Transitory Locations

- The goal of the 2020 Enumeration at Transitory Locations (ETL) operation is to enumerate individuals in occupied units at transitory locations who do not have a Usual Home Elsewhere (UHE).
- A transitory location (TL) is a location that is comprised of living quarters where people are unlikely to live year round, due to the transitory/temporary/impermanent nature of these living quarters.
- Transitory locations include:
 - Recreational Vehicle Parks,
 - Campgrounds,
 - Racetracks,
 - Circuses,
 - Carnivals,
 - Marinas
 - Hotels

ETL is a paper-based operation for the 2020 Census.

Enumerators will canvass a transitory location in one visit to enumerate all occupied transitory units

#	Title	Description	Mitigation
9	Hotels/Motels become quarantine facilities/ being used to house people experiencing homelessness – Already realized	Hotels/motels previously considered TLs could become SBE locations or housing facility for quarantined people	Explore Alternative Dates to Provide This Population an Opportunity to Be Counted in the 2020 Census <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discuss with providers who work with this population (e.g. The Salvation Army, VA, etc.)
10	TLs cease operations due to ban/quarantine (e.g. carnivals) – Already realized	City or State Government bans large crowds and gatherings due to exposure risk, such as parks, etc.	Explore alternative methods of creating specific universe (e.g. carnival/circuses) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allow local knowledge to help with determining that universe. If there is a scheduled event, an appointment for enumeration would be set.
