
IAC BCU Completion Progress (as of 9/22/20)


IAC Housing Unit Enumeration Progress (as of 9/22/20)


IAC Group Quarters Enumeration Progress (as of 9/22/20)


IAC Transitory Locations Enumeration Progress (as of 9/22/20)

- Data collection materials shipped on 9/5, and received at NPC on 9/15
- Public Thank You events scheduled for 9/11 in Tutuila and 9/12 in Manu'a




CNMI

- Clerical review and follow-up activities are complete. Boxing is underway and shipping of questionnaires and address registers is scheduled for 9/29.
- Continued to hand out promotion shirts and bags at the final “Thank you” roadside wave events in Tinian and Rota

Guam

- On 8/21, the governor issued a stay-at-home order, which closed the Guam Census Office for two weeks. During that time, a small team led by the Advisor was able to process completed BCUs and conduct clerical review of materials.
- On 9/4, the Guam Census Office was given an exemption to return to office operations, including telephone enumeration, at a 50% staffing reduction.

- Continued Community Engagement & Communication Campaign work




USVI – St. Thomas/St. John District

- Effective 8/17, the governor issued a stay-at-home order due to increases in COVID-19 cases. All non-essential businesses closed, and non-essential workers were ordered to stay home.
- On 8/27, the USVI Census Offices received approval from the governor to continue normal telephone contact center operations and to resume door-to-door enumeration.
- Small island enumeration was successfully conducted from 9/2-9/3. This included interviewing residents and verifying that there were no housing units on over 20 islands.


