

ACS Basics

- Ongoing monthly survey sent to 3.5 million addresses per year to produce annual detailed population and housing estimates
 - The Census Bureau mails questionnaires to approximately 295,000 addresses a month across the United States.
 - Visit 20,000 Group Quarter facilities and sample approximately 194,000 residents each year
- Designed to produce *critical information on small areas and small population groups* previously collected on the decennial long form
- Data released three times each year
 - 1-year estimates (12 months of data)
 - 1-year Supplemental Estimates (12 months of data)
 - 5-year estimates (60 months of data)





Foreign Born

Foreign Born and Native Born

Native born – Anyone who *is* a U.S. citizen at birth

- Born in the United States, Puerto Rico, or U.S. Island Area (e.g., Guam)
- Born abroad of U.S. citizen parent(s)

Foreign born – Anyone who *is not* a U.S. citizen at birth

- Naturalized U.S. citizens
 - Legal permanent residents
 - Temporary migrants
 - Humanitarian migrants
 - Unauthorized migrants
- } Noncitizens

Race and Ethnicity

- In 1977, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued Directive 15 Policy on racial and ethnic classification for data. The 1977 OMB Race and Ethnic standards maintain that ethnicity (“Hispanic” or “Not Hispanic”) is a separate and distinct concept from race (“White,” “Black,” “American Indian or Alaskan Native,” or “Asian or Pacific Islander”.) Therefore individuals who are Hispanic may be of any Race.

Ancestry Definition

- Ancestry refers to a person's ethnic origin or descent, "roots," or heritage, or the place of birth of the person or the person's parents or ancestors before their arrival in the United States.
- The intent of the ancestry question is *not to measure the degree of attachment* the respondent had to a particular ethnicity. For example, a response of "Irish" might reflect total involvement in an "Irish" community or only a memory of ancestors several generations removed from the individual.
- A person's ancestry is not necessarily the same as his or her place of birth.

Selected Population Profiles

- 2011-2015 estimates
- 416 race, Hispanic origin, ancestry and tribal groups
- Must have a national population estimate of at least 7,000
- Available at lower levels of geography
- Comparable with 2006-2010 SPP release
- Includes data for over 20 ancestry groups that were not available in the 2006-2010 release, such as New Zealander, Romani, Saudi Arabian, Tunisian and Ugandan
- Topics include: educational attainment, fertility, nativity, income, poverty and homeownership.



Statistical Testing Tool



Comparing American Community Survey (ACS) estimates involves more than determining which statistic is higher or lower. Users should also conduct statistical testing to make sure differences are statistically significant and are unlikely to have occurred by chance. This testing takes into account the margin of error (MOE) associated with survey estimates, which are based on responses from only a sample of the full population.

Looking for an easy way to conduct statistical testing? Try the Census Bureau's new Statistical Testing Tool. Simply copy or download ACS estimates and their MOEs into the spreadsheet to get instant results of statistical tests.

Tool Features:

- Compares up to 3,230 pairs of estimates at once
- Compares multiple estimates simultaneously (up to 150 estimates)
- Displays statistical testing results ("Yes", "No") automatically
- Handles special formatting and characters, such as the '+/-' in front of the MOE, without additional editing by the data user
- Uses the Census Bureau's standard 90% confidence level, but can also process statistical testing at 95% or 99% confidence levels
- May be used to conduct statistical testing for other Census Bureau surveys


