- 2) The 2006-2008 American Community Survey 3-Year Summary File contains exactly the same table format and content as the 2008 ACS Summary File.

- 4) Because of added/dropped tables, changes were made to some of the tables in the sequences. Sequences 51 and 146 contain geo-restricted tables, so there are many missing tables in these sequences. Sequences 125-133 contain 3 new large median tables (these tables contain 499 cells). Due to the size restriction on the sequences (no more than 245 cells), each of the tables was broken into 3 sequences. For example, sequence 125 contains B24121 cells 1-167, sequence 126 contains B24121 cells 168-333, and sequence 127 contains B24121 cells 334-499. For more details,

SUBJECT CONTENT

The American Community Survey (ACS) is the largest household survey in the United States, with an annual sample size of about 3 million addresses. Every year the ACS

supports the release of single-year estimates for geographic areas with populations of 65,000 or more.

This release of the American Community Survey Production Summary file (ACS-SF) contains the 2006-2008 detailed tables (a.k.a. “base tables”). Please send any comments you have via email to: nicholas.m.spanos@census.gov. We will keep users aware of any updates via the ACS Alert from the ACS website.

The 2006, 2007, 2008 data products include the Group Quarters (GQ) population. The GQ population includes all people not living in households. ACS data were collected from residents who were currently residing in the GQs when the ACS was conducted at that location. Data are collected at two types of group quarters: institutional, including residences such as correctional facilities, nursing homes, and psychiatric hospitals; and non-institutional, which include residences such as college dormitories, military barracks, group homes, and shelters.

Every table that should be a “total population” table will include the GQ population. But, tables describing household characteristics will not include GQ data. For example, tables such as Median Household Income, will only have data from the population living in households.

The ACS-SF contains sample data, which is information about the characteristics of local communities compiled from the questions asked of a sample of people and housing units. The ACS covers a broad spectrum of geographic areas in the United States and Puerto Rico. The topics listed below are covered by the ACS and focus on demographic, social, housing, and economic characteristics.

The Census Bureau uses the data collected by the ACS to create estimates and variances, which are termed statistics, for these characteristics. The statistics produced from the ACS describe the characteristics of population and housing in the United States and Puerto Rico. The ACS releases statistics in several forms – totals, proportions, percentages, means, medians, averages, and ratios. There are three sets of data files in identical format with one field per estimate. One file contains the estimates, the second file contains the standard errors, and the third file contains the margin of error.

The ACS-SF contains published ACS detailed tables. Of these tables, ID's beginning with the letter "C" are collapsed versions of tables (i.e. these tables have fewer detailed cells). These detailed tables include both U.S. and Puerto Rico population and housing characteristics for the housing unit population and for a limited list of race and Hispanic or Latino groups. Population and housing items may be cross tabulated. Selected aggregates and medians are also provided. A complete listing of subjects in this file is found in the section, "**Subject Locator**".

GEOGRAPHIC CONTENT

The ACS Production Summary file includes all detailed tables for all geographic areas published by the 2008 ACS. The main directory of the ACS-Summary File's FTP server (http://www2.census.gov/acs2008_3yr/summaryfile/) contains documentation on using the ACS-SF and 53 subdirectories, for the United States, the 50 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. The file structures are identical for all files, but the geographic coverage differs.

This abstract lists the most frequently accessed geographic levels. The "Summary Level Sequence Chart" section outlines the hierarchical and inventory geographic summaries in their entirety. Two summary level sequence charts are provided: one for the state files and one for the final national file.

INTRODUCTION

“How to Use the ACS Summary File” is intended to be used as a guide for data users to the American Community Survey (ACS) summary file and the documentation. New users should review this chapter before using the ACS Summary File.

DATA FORMAT

All ACS Summary File (ACS-SF) are available in the .zip format, which is a compressed format to reduce the file size. Users can download the .zip files through the File Transfer Protocol (FTP) from the American Community Survey FTP site located at URL: http://www2.census.gov/acs2008_3yr/summaryfile/. The ACS-SF will need to be unzipped before they can be read.

The FTP site has 53 directories for the data, which include the United States, the 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and example SAS programs. In each directory, there is a geography file for the selected area, and the .zip files are then organized by the geographic areas. For the user’s convenience, if users want the .zip files for all the geographies under a particular directory, the file `all_<state/dc/pr/us>.zip` contains all the files in the directory. This allows the users to save time and not have to download each individual file.

After unzipping the ACS-SF, three ASCII (plain text) files are available, one file for the estimates, one for the margins of error, and one for the standard errors. Each ACS-SF includes detailed tables for all of the geographic areas published in 2008 and a geographic header record file in a fixed field; the geographic header record file's data portion includes a geographic link in the comma-delimited format. For more information

on the files and their purposes refer to the README file in the main directory on the FTP site.

FILE NAMING CONVENTIONS





Figure 2.2 Geoheader Summary File Naming Convention Example

The .zip file names for all of the files follow a predefined structure. The naming convention will enable a user and/or a computer program to determine the contents of a file from its name. Figures 2.1 and 2.2 displays an overview of the file naming conventions.

ACS SF file naming convention for the data summary file names will be *tyyyyppggssssiterr.zip*:

- *t* = type of data (e=estimate, m=margin of error, s=standard error)
- *yyyy* = reference year for the data, e.g., 2008
- *p* = period covered by the file (1=1-year, 3=3-year, 5=5-year)
- *gg* = geographic area (state or US) covered by the file; 'PR' for the Puerto Rico Community Survey
- *ssss* = file sequence number (valid range is 0001 through 9999)

This sequence number will be used in a manner similar to the approach taken for the SF3. Each sequence number will correspond to a series of detailed tables. Each record of this file will be for a unique geographic area published by the ACS. All the data cells contained in the detailed tables for that geographic area would be on this record. There will be a file for the estimates and a separate one for the standard errors.

- *iter* = '000', placeholder for future values for iteration
- *r* = data revision indicator, only present if needed. 'a', 'b', etc

The ACS-SF file naming convention for the geographic header files will be *tyyyyppgg.txt*:

- *t* = type of data (g= geographic header file)
- *yyyy* = reference year for the data, e.g., 2008
- *p* = period covered by the file (1=1-year, 3=3-year, 5=5-year)
- *gg* = geographic area (state or US) covered by the file; 'PR' for the Puerto Rico Community Survey

Figure 2.1 Zip File Naming Convention Example

READING THE GEOGRAPHIC HEADER RECORD

The geographic header record layout is below (Table 2.1). The information in each summary level column is a guide to the presence or absence of additional geographic information on that specific summary level. In each row of a particular geographic area code, there is a listing of the summary levels that contain the area code. For example, to uniquely identify a county (summary level 050) you need to know the state and county code. There are 9 Brown counties in the U.S. and in order to identify it uniquely you need to know the state.


Note: The Geographic Summary Levels that are designated, as “Reserved for future use” will be used for the ACS period estimate data products. These reference names will not be defined in the ACS Geographic Terms and Concepts section until they are used.

GEOGRAPHIC HIERARCHY PRIMER

Detailed information on ACS summary levels can be found in Chapter 4. Chapter 4 identifies each geographic level and provides the code for the level. Figure 2.3 provides an example of the various geographic hierarchies used in the American Community Survey. Take some time to review this chart to become familiar with the different hierarchies.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Let's say you want to create Table B08406, "Sex of workers by means of transportation to work for workplace geography," for the state of Alaska from the files on the ftp site http://www2.census.gov/acs2008_3yr/summaryfile/. Which files do you need? How do you read the files?

You will need three files:

1. The data dictionary (merge_5_6_final.xls)
2. The data file (e20083ak0001000.txt)
3. The geography file (g20083ak.txt)

Start with the data dictionary, merge_5_6_final.xls. Under the "Tblid" column, look for the value "B08406". You will see that the "Sequence Number" is "0003." This means that the data you looking for are in the file "e20083ak0003000.txt". How do we know this is the right file? We know this from the name of the file: the "e" stands for estimate, 2008 is the year, "ak" is the state (Alaska), and "0003" is the sequence number (which contains the data for Table B08406). See the "File Naming Conventions" section in Chapter 2.

Then use the geography file for Alaska to determine the location within the state to which the data refer. The appropriate file is g20081ak.txt, where "g" means "geography", 2008 is the year, 3 is the period estimate (in this case, 3-year estimate), and ak is the state. (For each state, the geography file contains the lower-case postal-abbreviation of the state.)

When you open the data file, e20083ak0001000.txt (the data file), you will see the following comma-delimited fields on the first line:

```

The first six fields – from "ACSSF" to "0000001" – are identifiers.

- A. The first field tells you that this is an ACS Summary File;
- B. The second tells you that these data are one-year estimates for the year 2008 (notice the "e" before "2008" and the "1" at the end);
- C. The third tells you the state ("ak" is Alaska);
- D. The fourth is an iteration number;
- E. The fifth is the all-important sequence number;
- F. The last is a logical record code (LOGRECNO). The LOGRECNO identifies the location within a state.


The geography file, g20081ak.txt, describes the LOGRECNO. Each LOGRECNO specifies a location pertaining to the state. For example, a LOGRECNO of "0000001" means the state of Alaska; a LOGRECNO of "0000002" means just the urban areas in Alaska; a LOGRECNO of "0000003" refers to just rural areas in Alaska. Notice that each state has its own geography file.

The other fields in the data file, from the seventh on, are data values. Each field corresponds to the value of the “line number” variable in the data dictionary. So field number seven (the 335039 value, after the sixth comma) corresponds to line number one, which is “Total”. Field number eight (the 264535 value, after the seventh comma) refers to line number two, which is “Car, Truck, or Van.” Field number nine (the 219908 value) corresponds to line number three, which is “Drove alone.” This continues all the way up to line number 51, at which point Table B08406 ends.

Were you to read this into a computer program using software such as SAS, you could translate the first ten fields of line number one in e20083k0001000.txt as follows:

Figure 2.4 Linking Geographic Header File to the Data Files




DATA STRUCTURE AND SEGMENTATION

Each ACS-SF consists of 475 physical files: one geographic header file and 474 data files, of which 158 contain estimates, 158 contain standard errors, and 158 contain margins of error. The larger size of the tables made it necessary to divide the files into smaller segments. Figure 2.5 displays the overview of the contents in an ACS Summary File. Additional information on file/table segmentation can be found in Chapter 5: List of Tables.

A logical unique record number is assigned to all files for a specific geographic entity. This is done so that all records for a specific entity can be linked together across files. Besides the logical record number, other identifying fields are also carried over from the geographic header file to the table files. These are file identification, state/U.S. abbreviation, and characteristic. For SAS users, a SAS program for importing the data files is provided in the main directory of the ACS-Summary File's FTP site.

Appendix A

ACS Geographic Terms and Concepts

The Geographic Terms and Concepts used in the American Community Survey are the same as other Census Bureau products with the exception of those listed below. See the Census 2000 Geographic Terms and Concepts [PDF] at <http://www.census.gov/geo/www/tiger/glossry2.pdf> or the Geographic Areas Reference Manual (GARM – vintage 1990) at <http://www.census.gov/geo/www/garm.html> for definitions of other geographic terms and concepts. The ACS is conducted in the United States and Puerto Rico. In Puerto Rico, the survey is known as the Puerto Rico Community Survey or PRCS.

Combined New England City and Town Area (CNECTA) – Adjacent New England City and Town Areas (see glossary term New England City and Town Area) that have a high degree of employment interchange may be combined to form Combined New England City and Town Areas (or CNECTAs). New England City and Town Areas that are part of a CNECTA retain their separate identities.

Combined Statistical Area (CSA) – Defined by the federal Office of Management and Budget for use by federal statistical agencies according to the Census data, adjacent metropolitan and micropolitan statistical areas may be combined to form a CSA if the areas have a high degree of employment interchange. Each metropolitan or micropolitan statistical area retains its own identity.

Core Based Statistical Area (CBSA) – Core Based Statistical Area is a collective term for both metropolitan and micropolitan areas.

Metropolitan Division – A metropolitan statistical area with population greater than 2.5 million may be divided into smaller groups known as metropolitan divisions.

Metropolitan Statistical Area/Micropolitan Statistical Area – Metropolitan and micropolitan statistical areas (metro and micro areas) are geographic entities defined by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget for use by Federal statistical agencies in collecting, tabulating, and publishing Federal statistics. A metro area contains a core urban area of 50,000 or more population, and a micro area contains an urban core of at least 10,000 (but less than 50,000) population. Each metro or micro area consists of one or more counties and includes the counties containing the core urban area, as well as any adjacent counties that have a high degree of social and economic integration (as measured by commuting to work) with the urban core.

New England City and Town Area (NECTA) – is a geographic entity defined by the U.S. Office of Management and Budget for use by Federal statistical agencies in describing aspects of the New England region in the United States. NECTA is based on the concept of a core area with a large population nucleus, plus adjacent communities having a high degree of economic and social integration with that core. Similar to the metropolitan and micropolitan statistical areas, a metropolitan NECTA has an urban core

of at least 50,000 population, while a micropolitan NECTA has an urban core of at least 10,000 inhabitants but less than 50,000.

New England City and Town Area (NECTA) Division – A New England City and Town Area with population greater than 2.5 million may be divided into smaller groups known as NECTA Divisions.

State Designated Tribal Statistical Area (SDTSA) – Statistical entities for state recognized American Indian tribes that do not have a state recognized land base (reservation). SDTSAs are identified and delineated for the U.S. Census Bureau by a state liaison identified by the governor's office in each state. Formerly known as State Designated American Indian Statistical Area (SDAISA).

The American Community Survey is conducted using three methods of data collection to contact households:

- Mail: Self-enumeration through mail-out/mail-back
- Telephone: Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI)
- Personal Visits: Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI)

Self-enumeration through mail-out/mail-back methodology -- The self-enumeration procedure uses several mailing pieces:

- a prenotice letter
 - the American Community Survey questionnaire
 - a reminder card
 - and a replacement questionnaire if the original questionnaire is not returned in a timely manner
- Sample Addresses that do not respond by mail may be contacted using the follow-up procedures CATI, CAPI, or both

Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI)-- The CATI operation is conducted approximately six weeks after the American Community Survey questionnaire is mailed. We will attempt to obtain telephone numbers and conduct telephone interviews for all households that have not responded by mail during the six-week period. Census Bureau telephone interviewing staff will conduct these interviews.

Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI)-- Following the CATI operation, a sample will be taken from the addresses that remain uninterviewed. These addresses are visited by Census Bureau field representatives, who will conduct personal interviews.

Appendix H

Examples of Standard Error Calculations

We will present some examples based on the real data to demonstrate the use of the formulas.

Example 1 - Calculating the Standard Error from the Confidence Interval

The estimated number of males, never married is 41,011,718 from summary table B12001 for the United States for 2008. The margin of error is 93,906.

$$\text{Standard Error} = \text{Margin of Error} / 1.645$$

Calculating the standard error using the margin of error, we have:

$$SE(41,011,718) = 93,906 / 1.645 = 57,086.$$

Example 2 - Calculating the Standard Error of a Sum

We are interested in the number of people who have never been married. From Example 1, we know the number of males, never married is 41,011,718. From summary table B12001 we have the number of females, never married is 34,893,327 with a margin of error of 81,141. So, the estimated number of people who have never been married is $41,011,718 + 34,893,327 = 75,905,045$. To calculate the standard error of this sum, we need the standard errors of the two estimates in the sum. We have the standard error for the number of males never married from example 1 as 57,086. The standard error for the number of females never married is calculated using the margin of error:

$$SE(34,893,327) = 81,141 / 1.645 = 49,326.$$

So using the formula for the standard error of a sum or difference we have:

$$SE(75,905,045) = \sqrt{57,086^2 + 49,326^2} = 75,444$$

Caution: This method, however, will underestimate (overestimate) the standard error if the two items in a sum are highly positively (negatively) correlated or if the two items in a difference are highly negatively (positively) correlated.

To calculate the lower and upper bounds of the 90 percent confidence interval around 75,905,045 using the standard error, simply multiply 75,444 by 1.645, then add and subtract the product from 75,905,045. Thus the 90 percent confidence interval for this estimate is $[75,905,045 - 1.645(75,444)]$ to $[75,905,045 + 1.645(75,444)]$ or 75,780,940 to 76,029,150.

Example 3 - Calculating the Standard Error of a Percent

We are interested in the percentage of females who have never been married to the number of people who have never been married. The number of females, never married is 34,893,327 and the number of people who have never been married is 75,905,045. To calculate the standard error of this sum, we need the standard errors of the two estimates in the sum. We have the standard error for the number of females never married from example 2 as 49,326 and the standard error for the number of people never married calculated from example 2 as 75,444.

The estimate is $(34,893,327 / 75,905,045) * 100\% = 45.97\%$

So, using the formula for the standard error of a proportion or percent, we have:

$$SE(45.97\%) = 100\% * \left(\frac{1}{75,905,045} \sqrt{49,326^2 - 0.4597^2 * 75,444^2} \right) = 0.05\%$$

To calculate the lower and upper bounds of the 90 percent confidence interval around 45.97 using the standard error, simply multiply 0.05 by 1.645, then add and subtract the product from 45.97. Thus the 90 percent confidence interval for this estimate is $[45.97 - 1.645(0.05)]$ to $[45.97 + 1.645(0.05)]$, or 45.89% to 46.05%.

Example 4 - Calculating the Standard Error of a Ratio

Now, let us calculate the estimate of the ratio of the number of unmarried males to the number of unmarried females and its standard error. From the above examples, the estimate for the number of unmarried men is 41,011,718 with a standard error of 57,086, and the estimates for the number of unmarried women is 34,893,327 with a standard error of 49,326.

The estimate of the ratio is $41,011,718 / 34,893,327 = 1.175$.

The standard error of this ratio is

$$SE(1.175) = \frac{1}{34,893,327} \sqrt{57,086^2 + 1.175^2 * 49,326^2} = 0.00233$$

The 90 percent margin of error for this estimate would be 0.00233 multiplied by 1.645, or about 0.004. The 90 percent lower and upper 90 percent confidence bounds would then be $[1.175 - 0.004]$ to $[1.175 + 0.004]$, or 1.171 and 1.179.

Example 5 - Calculating the Standard Error of a Product

We are interested in the number of 1-unit detached owner-occupied housing units. The number of owner-occupied housing units is 75,373,053 with a margin of error of 224,087 from subject table S2504 for 2008, and the percent of 1-unit detached owner-occupied housing units is 81.8% (0.818) with a margin of error of 0.1 (0.001). So the number of 1-unit detached owner-occupied housing units is $75,373,053 * 0.818 = 61,655,157$. Calculating the standard error for the estimates using the margin of error we have:

$$SE(75,373,053) = 224,087 / 1.645 = 136,223$$

and

$$SE(0.818) = 0.001 / 1.645 = 0.0006079$$

The standard error for number of 1-unit detached owner-occupied housing units is calculated using the formula for products as:

$$SE(61,655,157) = \sqrt{75,373,053^2 * .0006079^2 + 0.818^2 * 136,223^2} = 120,483$$

To calculate the lower and upper bounds of the 90 percent confidence interval around 61,655,157 using the standard error, simply multiply 120,483 by 1.645, then add and subtract the product from 61,655,157. Thus the 90 percent confidence interval for this estimate is $[61,655,157 - 1.645(120,483)]$ to $[61,655,157 + 1.645(120,483)]$ or 61,456,962 to 61,853,352.

Users should be cautioned that all methods in this section are approximations. They may be overestimates or underestimates of the estimate's standard error, and may not match direct calculations of standard errors or calculations obtained through other methods.

1) Jam Values

Some data values represent unique situations where either: a) the information to be conveyed is an explanation for the absence of data, represented by a symbol in the data display, such as "(X)", or b) the information to be conveyed is an open-ended distribution, such as 115 or greater, represented by 115+.

The following are the special data values (and their meaning), which can appear in the 2008 ACS Summary File table as an explanation for the absence of data:

Missing Value = “.”: A dot “.”, indicates that the estimate is unavailable. All ACS tables contain these values when estimates are missing due to certain special conditions.

Filtered Value or Geographic Restriction = “ ”: A blank indicates that a value is filtered or is not shown due to a geographic restriction.

Margin of Error (MOE) or Standard Error (SE) = 0: Estimate is controlled, which indicates the estimates are controlled and a statistical test is not appropriate.

2) Rounding Rules, Margin of Errors (MOE), and Standard Errors (SE)

A. B00001, B00002, B98001, and B98002 are sample counts, not estimates, and do not have MOE’s and SE’s associated with them. Tables in series B99* imputation tables and B98* quality measure tables (except B98001 and B98002) do not have MOEs calculated for them. The MOE and SE are set to -1 for these tables.

B. There are a few special rules on how certain margin of error and standard error are determined for ACS estimates. The accuracy of the estimate (decimal place) in the base tables to determine how many digits the standard error should be rounded.

The only exceptions to these rules are tables B19082: SHARES OF AGGREGATE HOUSEHOLD INCOME BY QUINTILE and B19083: GINI INDEX OF INCOME INEQUALITY. On American FactFinder (AFF), the estimates display to 2 decimal places and the MOE to 3.

3) Display of Estimates

Display of whole numbers in the summary files: The estimates in the summary files are stored using standard notation instead of in scientific notation. The largest estimate in the 2008 Summary File contains 14 digits, because since SAS was used to generate the 2008 Summary File, SAS automatically stores and displays values with more than 12 digits using scientific notation, but these values were stored in the summary files as whole numbers.

Display of decimal values in the summary files: The following median and ratio tables are displayed as decimals. The following list shows these tables, their table types, and accuracy.

4) Special Table ID Sequence Rules

The data from the American Community Survey contains 75 detailed tables that have different table layouts for the Puerto Rico than their United States counterparts. The United States version of the tables are limited to geographic areas in the US (50 states plus the District of Columbia) while the Puerto Rico versions are limited to areas in Puerto Rico. In the summary file the Puerto Rico version of the tables are in sequence file 149 through 158. Therefore, for all geographic areas within the US sequence files 149 through 158 will be blank. In addition, sequence files 1,2,23,24, 28-32, and 147 will be blank for Puerto Rico as they contain the US version of the tables. The decision to separate the files was made because the comparable tables between the US and Puerto Rico may have a different number of cells (such as C06001 with 45 cells and C06001PR with 37 cells) which would significantly alter the metadata between the US and Puerto Rico. To identify what tables are available for Puerto Rico only look for the "PR" suffix in the table id (e.g. C06001PR).

Sequences 51 and 146 contain many geo-restricted tables. Sequences 125-133 contain 3 large median tables with 499 cells. Due to the size restriction on the sequences (no more than 245 cells), each of the tables had to be broken into 3 sequences. So for example, sequence 125 contains B24121 cells 1-167, sequence 126 contains B24121 cells 168-333; sequence 127 contains B24121 cells 334-499, etc.

7) Data Release Filtering Rules

Data release filtering rules. Filtering rules, based on the statistical reliability of the survey estimates, are used because certain geographic areas contain very detailed tables might include estimates whose reliability is unacceptable. The main data release rule for the ACS tables works as follows. Every base table consists of a series of estimates. If more than half the estimates are not statistically different from 0 (at a 90 percent confidence level), then the table fails. Each estimate is subject to sampling variability that can be summarized by its standard error. Dividing the standard error by the estimate yields the coefficient of variation (CV) for each of the estimates. (If the estimate is 0, a CV of 100 percent is assigned.) To implement this requirement for each table at a given geographic area, CVs are calculated for each of the table's estimates, and the median CV value is determined. If the median CV value for the table is less than or equal to 61 percent, the table passes for that geographic area; if it is greater than 61 percent, the table fails. Tables that are too sparse will fail this test. In that case, the table will not be published for that geographic area. Whenever a table fails, a simpler table that collapses some of the detailed lines together can be substituted for the original, more detailed table. The rules are then applied to the simpler table. If it passes, the simpler table is released. If it fails, none of the estimates for that particular table is released for this geographic area. These rules are applied to single-year period estimates and multi-year period estimates based on three years of sample data.
