1. NYCH&VS Requests

The first request was denied. It could allow 1 respondent to know that another respondent lives in his/her building.

The second request is only acceptable if publishing all sets of geography does not violate the 100,000 population rule. A computer program would have to be used to look for “slivers” of geography that are exposed when the geographic areas overlap.

2. STP_022 ETA Youth Opportunity Grants

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. There must be at least 3 unweighted cases in a given universe and a given geographic area for the data to be shown.

3. More IRS Earned Income Credit Tables

These were approved.

4. SIPP 2004 Wave 1 Reciprocity History

This was approved. Only the year (not the month) of when a respondent first received and last received AFDC, SSI, or Food Stamps will be shown. Categories for AFDCTIME and TMFSTIME will be rolled up to make the 3% topcode requirement.

5. SIPP 2004 Waves 1-15

This was approved.

6. RDC Request 0423_(b) (6)

This was approved. The data will be weighted and rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. There must be at least 3 unweighted people from 3 different households in a given migration for the data to be shown.
