1. (b) (6) questions on responses to Congressional letters from constituents about ACS

The Census Bureau can answer questions on ACS or any other Census Bureau survey (including economic surveys), but we will not confirm or deny that a particular person, household, or establishment is in a given survey.

2. ST075-14 and ST075-15

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations. DRB rules for means and medians will be applied (this includes rounding of point medians). Complementary suppression and/or collapsing of categories or geography will be applied until the threshold of three unweighted observations is met. In the future, we would like to see the population sizes of all geographic areas to be identified such as neighborhoods and wards.

3. STP\_340 (b) (6)

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. There must be at least three households in a given geographic area in the particular universe (with at least one girl of age 3-6 or with at least one girl of age 7-10) for the tables to be shown.

4. ACS Table Shells for Review

This was tabled. Is this a special tab, and if so, what number? (b) (6) will get us the table counts. Should the DRB release any interim weights?
