1. NCHS file

The people requesting this data release did not attend the meeting as promised. This request was tabled because there are still several unanswered questions.

2. CPS ASEC 2007 (b) (6)/CMMS

This was approved.

3. (b) (6) /0606 (b) (6)

This was approved. All coefficients based on frequency counts of 1 or 2 should be suppressed. In the documentation, the "observation numbers" should be changed to "number of observations."

4. STP\_350 (b) (6)

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. DRB rules for means and medians will be applied. There must be at least 50 unweighted households in a county for the data to be shown. If a county does not meet the threshold, then the data for that county must either be suppressed (complementary suppression must be applied) or combined with another county or counties (perhaps a balance of state) to meet the threshold.

5. STP\_354 (b) (6)

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. There must be at least 50 unweighted households in each given universe and for each given county for the data to be shown.

6. HUD Threshold Sensitivity Testing

This was approved.

7. 0550 (b) (6)

This was approved.
