1. (b) (6) CBSA Exports

This was approved.

2. CTPP tabs for ACS 2005-2007

This was tentatively approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations. Because Group Quarters data are now synthesized, they may use the rounding scheme that rounds to base 5 rather than base 10. (b) (6) will put this in writing as an amendment to ACS special tab rules. DRB rules for means, medians, and other quantiles will be applied. There must be at least 3 unweighted cases for each category of means of transportation in a given geographic area for the data to be shown in all tables. Categories and/or geographic areas should be collapsed to meet this threshold. There must be at least 3 unweighted cases per pair of geographic areas in the flow tables with the exception of Total Workers (no required threshold). (b) (6) will wait on sending the memo because there may be further discussion. (b) (6) can you please inform the sponsors of this first discussion?

3. (b) (6) DraftFCB request
