1. National Longitudinal Mortality Study

This was approved. Age will be topcoded at 90. They will use the CPS public use file industry and occupation codes which ensure a threshold of 10,000 people at the national level for each category. They must cross all geographic variables (state, URB, and SMSAST) and ensure that each geographic area identified by this cross has a population of 100,000 or more. Categories of these variables must be removed or combined to meet this threshold. They must suppress any causes of death that occur only once or twice within a given state.

2. ACSO 03182008 CDC request

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations. It is understood that all geographic areas identified will have a population of 65,000 or more. This is approved for 2006 and 2007 data.

3. ACSO Texas 032008

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations. It is understood that all geographic areas identified will have a population of 65,000 or more.

4. ST079 of MN

Because of a potential subtraction problem with what has already been released, the Board did not approve the use of the new cutoff (\$22,000) for the 2007 data. The new cutoff can be used for the next year's data.
