1. American Housing Survey – National 2007

This is tentatively approved. (b) (6) will make sure that the down-payment variable (DWNPCT) was topcoded prior to deriving the percentage.

2. American Time Use Survey Public Use File

3. SIPP 2004 Wave 6

This was approved.

4. 0537_(b) (6)r

This is tentatively approved. (b) (6) will make sure that there are no disclosure problems with the means that currently do not seem correct.

5. ACS Group Quarters special tabulation rules

Laura will check with (b) (6) to see if the previous request was for just Nursing Homes or for Nursing Homes and Skilled Nursing Facilities (as they are often grouped together). (b) (6) will check with (b) (6) on specific current groupings:

Non-Institutional: College Dorms

Military

Other

Institutional: Nursing Homes and Skilled Nursing Facilities

Adult Correctional Facilities

Juvenile Correctional Facilities

Other

For a given geographic area, there must be at least 50 unweighted cases in any given type of facility (as well as 50 in an Other category) and those 50 cases must come from at least 3 different facilities. Categories may be combined to reach these thresholds. We are hoping that all states can meet these thresholds for the groupings listed above. If users want to divide states into parts, we must keep track of previous requests to ensure there are no complementary disclosure problems.
