1. CTPP continued discussion

The bar graphs of the weights were approved. We will ask (b) (6) what percent of base tables will fail because of high CVs and what percent of CTPP requested special tabulations will fail because of the threshold rule. We will also ask him to provide one or more examples of the set of special tabulations requested where there is only 1 person with a given means of transportation in a given geographic area to show how a microdata record can be constructed. (b) (6) will talk with those requesting the data about the DSEP appeal process.

2. FLD matching and re-interview test data

This was approved.

3. Consumer Expenditure Survey topcoding

The DRB would like all of the variables in (b) (6) list topcoded.

4. HUBERT estimates

Request numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, and 6 are approved. (b) (6) will get clarification on request number 5, and we will try to resolve this via email.

5. Identity Theft Supplement

This was approved. They will use the same rule on money lost variables (rounded to 2 significant digits if the value is over \$100 or rounded to the nearest multiple of 10 if under \$100). They will topcode 5% of unweighted continuous variable values. They will not include write-ins.
