1. Paradata release in public use microdata files --- example from NHIS

We need to know exactly what will be on the Consumer Expenditure file. We also have questions on some variables from the example. (b) (6) will relay this information to (b) (6) (BLS) and ask him to attend a DRB meeting in the near future.

2. STP_386 (b) (6)

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations. here must be at least 3 unweighted households represented in each value for each geographic area.

3. Graphs for Brookings and CBPP

This was approved.

4. 2008 COFA survey

This was approved. There must be at least 3 unweighted households represented in each case for each geographic area; otherwise cases should be combined to meet this threshold.

5. NCVS PUF

This was approved for quarters 1 and 2. Requests for future publications should be sent to the DRB.

6. Revised request comparing ACS and LEHD data

We will ask (b) (6) (Cambridge Systematics) to come in and meet with a subset of the DRB (probably (b) (6)) and (b) (6) to ensure that she understands the data and to discuss other issues (for example noting that these are not official Census Bureau estimates).
