1. Paradata Release for Consumer Expenditure Survey

There must be at least 3 different households in each geographic area contributing to each category in questions concerning language. (This will probably not be a problem since the categories are English, Spanish, and Other.) No write-in responses will be shown on the microdata file. (b) (6) will let us know what the “Other types of records used” variable is. The DRB does not want to show complete information on date and time of survey (for example Monday, March 16, 2009 at 10:23am). BLS staff will determine which of these variables are most useful for researchers. This is not the final request.

2. ACS 2006 Non-baby-boomer Profiles

This was approved at the national level.

3. ST075-29

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

4. ST075-28

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

5. ST075-30

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations. The Balance-of-State must have a population of 20,000 or more (some counties may need to be combined to meet this threshold).

6. STP\_388 (b) (6)

This was previously approved via email. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations.
