1. GAO SIPP/SSA Request

This was found to have no disclosure problems. HHES and OAES will resolve any other issues.

2. ACS 2004-2007 NAS Presentation

This was approved.

3. ACS PUMS Idea

This was approved to vet with other groups.

4. NCES – 2000 Custom Tabulation (Re-Tab)

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all Census 2000 special tabulations.

5. CTPP Request to Show Univariate Means<sup>18</sup> in the Flow Tables

This was approved.

6. CBSA Exports for January to June, 2008 for ITA

This was approved. They have still not decided whether to publish these 6 month tables because they would have to be concerned with complementary disclosures in the annual tables.

7. NYCH&VS Maps for HUD

Most people did not yet receive this request. It is tabled until next week.

8. Synthetic LBD – Disclosure Correlations

This was the beginning of a discussion. The Board wanted to know how often there is a correlation of 1.

9. Additional ACS DOJ Tables
