1. ACS 2007 Humes/Hogan special tab

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

2. 2006/2007 Annual Profile of Exporting Companies for ITA

This was approved.

3. SIPP 2008 Waves 1-13

This was approved.

4. A. ACS 2005-2007 special tab for HUD for CHAS

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

4. B. ACS 2007 special tab of income by household size for congressional districts

This was approved. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

5. Estimates for poverty in households and GQ tables in JSM paper

This was approved.

6. Public Use File for National Employer Survey

Rebecca will ask Kathleen Styles if OAES has any objection. We will gladly review a future, formal proposal. Our first thoughts are that it may have to be a national level file (no other geography), and details may be limited because it is a survey on establishments.

7. 2008 ACS 1 year PUMS

This was approved. The proposed GQ weight adjustment from Karen King is acceptable for this year, and we understand that more will be done in future years.

8. Continued discussion of ACS 5 year base tables

Laura will combine comments from last week and this week and send them to the group from review. We cannot make a final decision, because the proposal is not yet final. The B98* tables on non response rates will only be shown for states and for the nation (this was

corrected after the meeting to include counties for housing units.....see email from Mark Asiala that Laura sent Tuesday 6/30.... we can discuss further). We discussed other options (quality filters and individual race thresholds with complementary suppressions) for block group tables iterated by races A-I. The best option remains counting the races as a dimension and not publishing tables with more than 100 cells for block groups. Melissa Chiu will send us lists of transportation tables from Census 2000, ACS, and CTPP special tabulations.
