1. 2008 SIPP panel wave 3 welfare reform

The following 2 tables may be removed from the list of tables that cannot be published for block groups:

Tables where the universe is restricted to people less than 18 years old
Tables containing characteristics of non-relatives

Several tables in the list of tables that cannot be published for block groups are those “containing characteristics” of a given sub-population. Univariate counts of those subpopulations may still be published at the block group level.
