1. ACS 2006-2010 BEA

The threshold of 3 will be applied to means. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

2. Census 2000 (b) (6)

This was denied because it had far too much detailed information. They should use the PUMS.

3. Health Insurance SHIPP

This was approved. They must use the list of race combinations that meet the national 10,000 threshold rule.

4. ACS 2006-2010 Modern Language Association

There must be at least 3 unweighted cases of speakers of a given language for each age group in different households in a given geographic area for the data to be shown. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations.

5. CTPP ACS 5 year special tabulation

They are trying to introduce some new tables. (b) (6) and Laura will check to see if the new tables were approved for areas of residence and occupation, but not for the flow tables. Medians will be generated from an interpolated distribution. Any new flow tables could cause a major delay.

6. ACS ST203 Languages

There must be at least 3 unweighted cases of speakers of a given language in different households in a given geographic area for the data to be shown. The data will be rounded as all ACS special tabulations, and ratios and percentages will be generated from the rounded values.
