The percentage of people in the following groups were not highest in any St. Charles Parish census tracts: Hispanic or Latino, Asian, American Indian and Alaska (AIAN), Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander (NHOPI), "Two or more races, not Hispanic or Latino", and "Some other race, not Hispanic or Latino."

People of Hispanic origin who are not White were counted in the Hispanic or Latino group. These people were also counted in the AIAN, Asian, Black, or NHOPI group they indicated. Each of these people was counted twice in the comparison of percentages.
