## POPULATION ESTIMATES

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### ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES, BY AGE, COLOR, AND SEX: JULY 1, 1950, 1951, AND 1952

Substantial increases in the number of preschool-age children, elementary school-age children, and the aged, and declines in the number of young adults between April 1, 1950, the date of the last Census, and July 1, 1952, are reflected in estimates of the population of the United States, by age, color, and sex, released by Robert W. Burgess, Director, Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. Three types of population estimates are shown in this report: the population of the United States including armed forces overseas, and the total and civilian population residing in continental United States.

#### INDICATED CHANGES

Rather large variations from age group to age group in rates of growth between April 1, 1950, and July 1, 1952, are shown in the following table relating to the population residing in continental United States:

Perhaps the most striking change occurred in the group 5 to 9 years of age, which increased by 1.7 million, or 13.1 percent, in this period. The rate of growth for this group is more than three times the average of all age groups (3.4 percent). The age groups under 5 years and 10 to 14 years also showed substantial increases, 6.1 percent and 5.8 percent, respectively.

The number of children under 15 years of age, taken as a group, increased by about 3.4 million, or 8.3 percent, during the 1950-52 period. On July 1, 1952, there were 43,837,000 children in this group as compared with 40,483,000 2 1/4 years earlier. In contrast, during the corresponding period a decade ago, April 1, 1940, to July 1, 1942, this group increased by about 300,000, or approximately 1 percent.

The relatively large increase in the population under 15 years old, reflects the fact that many more babies were born between April 1950 and July 1952 than between April 1935 and July 1937. The number of children under 15 is expected to continue to increase at a rapid rate as persons born during the 1950's replace those born during the depression and prewar years.

The increase in the school-age population is currently being reflected in increases in enrollment in the elementary grades. On the assumption that enrollment rates do not change substantially, it is anticipated that enrollment in these grades will continue to increase by approximately one million each year for the next several years.

The adult population excluding armed forces overseas did not follow a consistent pattern of increases. Only moderate increases occurred in the age groups 30 to 64 years of age, ranging from 1.1 percent for the group 35 to 39 to 4.9 percent for the group 40 to 44. These were offset in part by declines in the age groups 20

to 29. These declines result in part from the recent increases in the number serving in the armed forces abroad. The population 65 years old and over showed a substantial gain of 6.8 percent during the 1950-52 period. This rate of growth is just double that for the total population.

Changes in the population including armed forces overseas and in the civilian population for the age groups between 15 and 44 years are as follows:

Sex ratios (the number of males per 100 females) in the population excluding armed forces overseas remained virtually unchanged at each age except the younger military ages between April 1, 1950, and July 1, 1952. During this period the sex ratio of the population 18 to 24 years of age declined from 96 to 90, primarily, as indicated above, because of the increased number of males serving in the armed forces overseas on July 1, 1952. Sex ratios by broad age groups, for April 1, 1950, and July 1, 1952, are as follows:

#### METHOD AND SOURCES

The estimates shown in this report are based on statistics from the 1950 Census of Population; statistics and estimates of births and deaths provided by the National Office of Vital Statistics, United States Public Health Service; statistics on the movement of civilian citizens and aliens to and from continental United States provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice;

and data on the size and distribution of the armed forces obtained from the Department of Defense.

The estimates of the number of persons in an age group on July 1, 1952, given in table 2, were obtained by adding to the number of persons in the corresponding group 2 1/4 years younger on April 1, 1950 (or to births since April 1950) an estimate of the net change arising from deaths and migration during the period following the census. For this purpose, the population enumerated as of April 1, 1950, was adjusted to include an estimate of persons serving in the armed forces of the United States overseas on that date. The estimates of the population in a given age group residing in continental United States (including armed forces stationed in the United States but excluding armed forces overseas), given in table 1, were obtained by subtracting an estimate of the number of persons in that age group in the armed forces overseas on July 1, 1952, from the figures including armed forces overseas shown in table 2. Similarly, the estimates of the civilian population in that age group given in table 3 were obtained by subtracting an estimate of the total armed forces in that age group (both at home and abroad) from the figures in table 2.

Population estimates for July 1, 1950 and 1951, were obtained in a manner similar to that used to obtain the estimates for July 1, 1952.

In the United States, as well as in many other countries, there has been a tendency for the census count to understate the number of children under 2 years of age to a greater extent than the number at the adjacent higher ages. On the basis of estimates of the number of children under 5 years of age for April 1, 1950, derived from statistics of births, deaths, and migration, it is estimated that the 1950 Census count understated the number of children under 2 years of age by about 639,000, or 9.0 percent, and of the children 2 to 4 years of age by about 167,000, or 1.6 percent. (Some of the understatement is accounted for by misreporting of age.) If the census count under 2 years of age were used as part of the base for an estimate, for example, of children 2 to 4 years of age on April 1, 1953, the change from 1950 to 1953 in the number in the age group 2 to 4 years would reflect the difference of 472,000 (that is, 639,000 minus 167,000) in the net undercounts for the two age groups in 1950. Therefore, in preparing the estimates shown in this report, the 1950 figures for single years under age 5 used as a base were estimates derived from births, not the census counts. At the same time, in order to maintain comparability with the 1950 Census figures, in the sense that the net change for a given age group between the census date and the estimate date would not include the net census undercount, the estimates of the "true" total number of children under 5 years of age, based on births, were deflated by the net census undercounts in the

same age group. The last lines of table 1 show the estimates for the age groups, under 1 year, 1 and 2 years, and 3 and 4 years, before deflation.

By the same procedure as described above, it was also possible to estimate the net undercounts (including misstatements of age) of children 5 to 14 years of age. However, since the adjustment for this age group would be somewhat smaller than that for children under 5 and also seemed less reliable, it was considered desirable to retain the original census figures as a base and make the adjustment only for children under 5 years.<sup>1</sup>

Large differences in net under- or overcounts exist in other segments of the census age distribution, such as in the region of age 65 years. Studies of the extent of these errors and of methods of making adjustment have not yet been completed, however.

The estimates of the civilian population given in this report are not consistent with

the estimates of the civilian noninstitutional population for dates prior to January 1, 1953, given in table 6 of Current Population Reports, Series P-57 (Monthly Report on the Labor Force), inasmuch as the latter were not based on data from the 1950 Census. The monthly estimates of the civilian noninstitutional population shown in the Current Population Survey were first based on the 1950 Census results in January 1953. As indicated in the text of Current Population Reports, Series P-57, No. 127, the population estimates shown here can be used, in conjunction with the population estimates published in table 6 of that report, as a basis for making rough revisions in the estimates of employment status for 1950 to 1952 by age and sex shown in earlier numbers of P-57, comparable with the estimates for January 1953 given in Series P-57, No. 127.

The population estimates presented here are not consistent with similar estimates for 1940 to 1949 previously published intermittently during the 1940 decade in Series P-25 and P-47, since the latter do not take into account the results of the 1950 Census. A revised set of intercensal age estimates for July 1 of each year, 1940 to 1949, taking into account both the 1940 and the 1950 Censuses and consistent with the postcensal estimates given here, is being prepared and will be available in several months.
