### PROVISIONAL ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES JANUARY 1, 1950, TO FEBRUARY 1, 1960

(Figures from February 1, 1959, to date include Alaska; figures from September 1, 1959, to date include Hawaii. Comparable estimates for each month, from January 1, 1950, to December 1, 1956, are given in Current Population Reports, Series P-25, No. 206)

The total population of the United States including Armed Forces abroad was about 179,452,000 on Feb. 1, 1960, according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase of 28,320,000,<sup>1</sup> or 18.7 percent, since April 1, 1950, the date of the last census, and an increase of 3,483,000,<sup>1</sup> or 2.0 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago. <sup>1</sup> Increase reflects inclusion of Alaska and Hawaii in figures starting with February 1, 1959, and September 1, 1959, respectively. A provisional estimate of the civilian population of Alaska on January 1, 1959, is 153,000; a provisional estimate of the civilian population of Hawaii on September 1, 1959, is 603,000. Alaska and Hawaii were admitted to the Union on January 3, 1959, and August 21, 1959, respectively.

the total population including Armed Forces abroad, of the population residing in United States (excluding Armed Forces abroad), and of the civilian population, for selected months back to January 1, 1950, are shown below.

The estimates presented in this report are based on the total population count from the 1950 Census; statistics and estimates of births and deaths provided by the National Office of Vital Statistics, United States Public Health Service; statistics on immigration and emigration provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice; and data on the Armed Forces provided by the Department of Defense. The figures on births and deaths have been adjusted for incomplete registration.
