ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES JANUARY 1, 1950, TO JUNE 1, 1960

(Figures from February 1, 1959, to date include Alaska; figures from September 1, 1959, to date include Hawaii. Comparable estimates for each month, from January 1, 1950, to December 1, 1957, are given in Current Population Reports, Series P-25, No. 216)

The total population residing in the United States (excluding Armed Forces abroad) was about 179,639,000 on June 1, 1960, according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase of 28,314,000, or 18.7 percent, since April 1, 1950, the date of the previous census, and an increase of 2,855,000, or 1.6 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago.¹ These estimates do not take account of the results of the 1960 Census, taken as of April 1; they are based on the 1950 Census count and statistics on births, deaths, immigration, and emigration for the 1950-60 decade.

The preliminary count of the population enumerated in the 50 States and the District of Columbia, on April 1, 1960, is 177,719,000 persons. Not included in this figure are persons in the following groups to be added to the count: persons enumerated away from home, including visitors and persons away on business, whom no one reported at their usual place of residence; persons who for various reasons

were enumerated too late to be included in the preliminary count for their States; and members of crews of American military and merchant vessels in ports of the United States on April 1, 1960. The preliminary counts are also subject to revision for other reasons. The final national total from the 1960 Census will become available in November of this year.

Estimates of the total population including Armed Forces abroad, of the population residing in the United States (excluding Armed Forces abroad), and of the civilian population, for selected months back to January 1, 1950, are shown below.

The estimates presented in this report are based on the total population count from the 1950 Census; statistics and estimates of births and deaths provided by the National Office of Vital Statistics, United States Public Health Service; statistics on immigration and emigration provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice; and data on the Armed Forces provided by the Department of Defense. The figures on births have been adjusted for incomplete registration.
