

## ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES, BY AGE, RACE, AND SEX: JULY 1, 1968

(Estimates shown here are consistent with figures for 1960 to 1963 published in Series P-25, No. 321, and with figures for 1964 to 1967 published in Series P-25, No. 385)

This report presents estimates of the population of the United States by age, sex, and race on July 1, 1968, with comparable figures for April 1, 1960, the date of the decennial census on which these estimates are based. The data are presented for three concepts of population coverage: total population including Armed Forces overseas, total resident population, and civilian resident population. See "Sources and method" for a more detailed discussion of coverage. Annual projections of the population aged 16 years and over, by sex and race to 1990, are also shown in an appendix.

### INDICATED CHANGES

The median age.--On July 1, 1968, half of the 201,166,000 Americans were 27.7 years of age or older, while the other half were younger. This median was unchanged from July 1, 1967, marking

the first time in 15 years that the median age had not been lower than in the previous year. The median age was 29.4 in 1960 and, in 1950, over 30 (table A). In 1820, the earliest year for which data for the complete population are available, the median age was 16.7. In its early years, the Republic had very high fertility rates and high mortality rates. As fertility declined throughout the 19th century and through the first three decades of the 20th century, the average age of the population continued to move upward. It reached its highest point in 1952: 30.3. It was not until 1953 that the cumulative effect of increases in fertility that followed World War II began to lower the median age.

Once the median age began to fall, its decline lasted for about the same length of time as the period in which high and increasing numbers of births were maintained. The baby boom that began in 1946 reached its highest point 15 years later, in fiscal year 1961, when 4,350,000 babies were born. Now, 15 years after the 1952 median age peak, the decline in the median age has probably halted. Even if the number of births holds steady or increases moderately, the median age would not drop much below its present level.



Age distribution.--The median age tells us at what point the age distribution of the population divides into two equal parts. It does nothing to describe the age distributions above and below this point. An age pyramid graphically provides detail for smaller age groupings over the full range of ages (figure 2).

Until the 1930 Census, pyramid representation by 5-year age groups of the United States population always showed the broadest bar at the base where the youngest age group is recorded. But in 1930 and 1940, the population under 5 years of age was smaller than the next older age group owing to declining fertility rates and the resultant drop in the number of births. By 1950, the period of very low fertility had ended and the base of the age pyramid again recorded the largest age group of the population. Once again, beginning in 1965, children under 5 years old have not been the most numerous age group.

The bars for the upper ages have tended to lengthen over time in relation to the younger ages. Improvement in survival rates along with declines in fertility have the result that, for the first time in the history of the United States, the number of persons aged 65 and over exceeds the number who are under age 5.

Population reaching selected ages.--Nearly one and one-half million persons reached age 65 during 1967-68, a number slightly greater than that of the previous year. This continued the gradual upward trend of the past two decades. By contrast, the population reaching age 21 showed a sharp increase during the past year (table B and figure 3). This is the vanguard of the baby boom that began when 1,075,000 more infants were born during fiscal year 1946-47 than in the previous year. The

progress of this cohort can easily be followed in figure 3. In 1953, these children reached age 6, the age for school entrance, and in 1961 they were in their teens. The population attaining age 14 in 1961 showed a big increase over the previous year. Now this cohort has reached age 21.

The amount and duration of the increase in births after 1946 attracted so much attention that consideration is rarely given to an earlier rise in the number of births in 1943. The survivors of this notable boomlet heralded the social and economic changes that were to be felt when the much larger cohorts of the post-World War II baby boom arrived at key ages. The 1943 cohort is easy to identify in figure 3 where it is seen to reach age 14 in 1957 and age 21 in 1964.



The 1950-68 period shown in table B does not encompass any abrupt annual change in births. The numbers born during these years continued to mount. Since 1961, births have declined each year. The decline has been of such extent that, in 1967-68, the number of births was 854,000 lower than the number that occurred during the peak year of 1960-61. The 1961 turning point has now affected the population of elementary school ages. Between 1967 and 1968, the number of persons reaching age 6 declined for the first time since 1955-56.

The number of young men who attained the military age of 18 during 1967-68 was slightly lower than the previous year, but it continued the relatively high level begun in 1965 when the survivors of 1947 births attained this age (table C). This reduction is temporary, since these 1,784,000 youths make up the male portion of a cohort that was born at a brief dip in the number of births. The number of males reaching age 14 and the number reaching age 21 were higher, in 1968, than the number of males who attained age 18.

Rates of growth by age.--Fewer persons were born in the year ending July 1, 1968, than in any year since fiscal 1946. The entire 0 to 4 group has been exhibiting decline for several years. This age group, which grew more than 25 percent during the 1950's, shows an 8.9 percent loss in numbers from 1960 to 1968 (table D). The age group 5 to 13 continues to grow; but, in the 1960's, its rate of growth is much lower than during the 1950's.

The biggest increase in rate of growth, and the most dramatic change in rates between the two decades, occurred for those in ages 18 to 24. During the 1950's, the persons who occupied this age group were those born in the 1930's. These small cohorts have gradually been replaced by larger cohorts that were born in the 1940's. Thus the 18 to 24 age group declined 1.1 percent from 1950 to 1960 but increased 43.0 percent from 1960 to 1968.

For the younger productive ages of 25 to 44, there have been low rates of growth and actual decline. Above age 44, the number of persons in the older productive ages has been growing more slowly than in the 1950's.

During the past 20 years, annual growth at ages 65 and over has occurred at increasingly slower rates. For the 20th century thus far, however, this remains the age group that has grown most rapidly. For about the first half of this century, the effects of long-term declining fertility and mortality as well as the high rates of immigration in the early decades of the century, favored higher rates of increase at the older ages relative to the younger ages. In the fiscal year 1967-68, the rate of growth at ages 65 and over still is higher than that for the population of all ages.

#### Age composition by sex and race.


Sex ratio.--In 1968, there were 96.6 males to every 100 females. The sex ratio was 97.8 in 1960 and 99.2 in 1950 (table 5). Before 1940, the number of males in the total population was larger than the number of females.

The sex ratio varies considerably by age. Males exceed females at the younger ages, since more males than females are born each year. For the population under 15 years of age, the sex ratio was 103.8 on July 1, 1968. Mortality, however, is higher for males than for females at every age and causes the sex ratio to drop as the population ages. The ratio is 102.8 for ages 15 to 24. At about age 27 the balance shifts to an excess of females and remains so for every older age.<sup>1</sup> Until age 44 the percentage of difference between the two sexes is relatively minor; for the broad age groups below this point that are shown in table 5, the sex ratio does not deviate from 100 by as much as 4 points. The ratio for the population aged 65 and over was 74.9 on July 1, 1968.

Median age.--As indicated previously, 1820 is the earliest year for which age data are available for the total population. In most of the years since that time, males, on the average, have been older than females (table A). Males were more than a year older in 1920. After 1920, and especially during the 1930's when both immigration rates and birth rates were very low, the median age of females began to catch up to that of the males and then to overtake it (figure 1). By this measure the American male is, at present, two and a half years younger than the female.

Age composition by race.--Data about the nonwhite population are dominated by the representation of the Negro population. In 1960, Negroes constituted 92 percent of the nonwhite population. Since about 1953, changes in the growth rates of the white, the nonwhite, and the Negro populations have been similar. Pronounced variations can be observed in years prior to 1953 (figure 4).

Since 1960, the Negro population has increased 18.2 percent while the white population increased only 10.8 percent (table E), but the higher growth rate of the Negro population is more striking at the younger ages. The Negro population 5 to 13 years of age grew 25.1 percent while the white population for this group grew only 11.9 percent. By contrast, for the population 65 and over, the growth rates for the white and Negro populations were nearly the same.

The higher fertility of the Negro population has resulted in a much lower average age than

that of the white population. The differential was small before 1850: less than 1 year (table A).<sup>2</sup> Later in the 19th century, the nonwhite median age climbed steadily, but at a lower rate than the white, and by 1965 the median for the nonwhite population was more than 7 years below that of the white population. The difference has not increased since 1965; some reduction of it may be under way.

Both the white and the Negro sex ratios are highest at the youngest ages and, consistently declining, lowest at age 65 and over (table 5). At age 65 and over, the sex ratio is higher for Negroes than for whites. At all other ages, and for the population of all ages, the ratio of males to females is higher for whites. The greatest disparity between the races is observed for young adults--

the sex ratio for the white population age 25 to 44 is 98.8 as compared to 88.3 for Negroes. Some of this apparent difference may be attributable to net census undercount, for males are less completely counted than females and nonwhites are less completely counted than whites. These two factors, when combined, depress the sex ratio of the enumerated nonwhite population more than that of the white population.

#### SOURCES AND METHOD

General sources and method.--The estimates of United States population for July 1, 1968, are based on (1) statistics from the 1960 Census of Population and estimates of births and deaths provided by the National Center for Health Statistics of the U.S. Public Health Service, (2) statistics on the number of immigrant aliens admitted to the United States as reported by the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the Department of Justice, (3) data on the size and distribution of the Armed Forces obtained from the Statistical Services Center of the Department of Defense and from the various branches of the military service, and (4) from the Civil Service Commission and the Department of Defense, data on the number of civilian Federal employees overseas, their dependents, and dependents of the Armed Forces overseas. Supplemental data on movement to the mainland have been reported by the Government of Puerto Rico.

The estimates have been made by the cohort-component method, employing the total population including Armed Forces overseas as of April 1, 1960, and data on changes since that date. This method involves bringing forward the population, from the census date to the estimate date, by

aging the population according to the length of the estimate period and by assigning births, deaths, and net immigrants, during the estimate period, to the proper age group.

Estimates of the total population including Armed Forces overseas cover, in addition to residents of the 50 States and the District of Columbia, those Armed Forces stationed in foreign countries and in outlying areas that are under United States sovereignty or jurisdiction. Total resident population is the coverage that conforms to the United States population for which the principal tabulations of the decennial census reports are made. To obtain estimates of the total resident population, estimates of the number of Armed Forces overseas are subtracted from the estimate of total population including Armed Forces overseas. The civilian resident population has been estimated by subtracting estimates of all Armed Forces, those stationed within the United States and those overseas, from the total population including Armed Forces overseas. The estimates by age, color, and sex for July 1, 1968, given in this report were based on, and are comparable with, the estimates for July 1, 1964 to 1967 that were published in Current Population Reports, Series P-25, No. 385. These were based on 1963 estimates as they appeared in No. 321 of the same series. These estimates had, in turn, been developed from estimates of population by age, sex, and color for each prior year back to 1960. The estimates for the Negro population were similarly developed from the estimates of prior years. Estimates for each year are carried forward through the use of data on births, deaths, and immigration. The estimates published in this report are subject to a final revision after the 1970 Census figures become available.

Base population in 1960.--The population estimates are based on complete-count population figures from the 1960 Census tabulated by age, color, and sex. The age detail from the count is for 5-year age groups for ages under 85 years old and for single years of age for ages under 21 years old. To facilitate the computations, the population for ages 21 to 84 was also distributed by single years. The population 21 to 24 years of age, including Armed Forces overseas, was distributed in proportion to annual births from 1935 to 1939. Since births were much less completely registered in the years before 1935, and since immigration contributed substantially to population growth in the pre-Depression years, birth statistics were less useful for distributing grouped data by single years of age for the older population. Instead, the 5-year age groups by color and sex of the population including Armed Forces overseas were distributed by osculatory interpolation. This mathematical form of interpolation provided a series of figures for single years of age which is consistent with the 5-year age totals, and shows a smooth transition from one age group to the next. In order to provide a smooth juncture between the figures for single years of age based on births for ages 21 to 24 and those obtained by mathematical interpolation for ages 30 and over, the figures for single years of age for the 25- to 29-year age group were derived by averaging the results of the two methods. The procedure involved splicing the two series over the five ages by applying shifting pairs of complementary weights to the original pairs of estimates, each series of weights forming a linear progression.

Data for the Negro population by single years of age and sex are not available from the 1960 Census, and data by 5-year age groups are available only from the 25-percent sample. Therefore, the 25-percent sample data for Negroes were used as the base population and were adjusted in proportion to complete-count data for nonwhites by 5-year age groups to improve the distribution by age. Conversion of the 5-year data to single years of age for the population 30 years and over for Negroes and for nonwhite was obtained by osculatory interpolation as described above.

For ages under 30, the Negro population was obtained by applying the percent Negro to total nonwhite by single years of age. The percent Negro of the total nonwhite population was available for 5-year age groups and was estimated for single ages by straight-line interpolation.

Estimates of births and deaths.--The estimates of births and deaths are based on tabulations of vital statistics for the resident population made by the National Center for Health Statistics, U.S. Public

Health Service. The estimates for 1968 have employed preliminary tabulations from January 1, 1966, to June 30, 1968. Births for whites and nonwhites were corrected for under-registration by factors determined by extending to subsequent years the results of the Birth Registration Test conducted by the Public Health Service and the Bureau of the Census in conjunction with the 1950 Census. No similar registration test was conducted in 1960. The percent completeness of birth registration for 1967 was estimated provisionally to be 99.4 percent for whites and 97.3 percent for nonwhites. Negro births were adjusted for under-registration by the factors for nonwhites.

Deaths in 1967 and the first half of 1968 were distributed by age, race, and sex, partly on the basis of a tabulation of a 10 percent sample of death certificates for 1966 and 1967, and on the basis of final tabulations for 1965. Data provided by the Department of Defense and by the National Center for Health Statistics of the Public Health Service have been used to estimate deaths of military personnel.

Net immigration.--Available and pertinent statistics on net civilian immigration are composed of four categories: (1) immigrant aliens from overseas; (2) net movement of citizens to and from residences overseas; (3) net arrivals from Puerto Rico; (4) conditional entrants. The estimate of net immigration for July 1, 1967, to June 30, 1968, was based on component data for the previous year. The age, sex, and race distribution for July 1, 1967, to June 30, 1968, was assumed to be the same as for July 1, 1965, to June 30, 1966.

1. Alien immigration from overseas.--The Immigration and Naturalization Service reports the number of alien immigrants by age and sex on a fiscal year basis. For the present estimates, immigration data through June 1967 were employed. The data for each year include alien immigrant arrivals in that year who intended to reside here permanently. There are no current data available on the number of alien emigrants. The Immigration and Naturalization Service ceased obtaining information on the race of immigrants after 1961. Estimates of the color of alien immigrants since 1961 were based on the reported country of origin of alien immigrants. The color composition of immigrants from each country was estimated from 1960 Census data on the color composition of the population born in each country. The estimates of Negro immigration, by age, for 1965 to 1966 are based on the previously made estimates of nonwhite alien immigration by country of origin grouped according to the predominance of Negroes or other nonwhites in the population. It was assumed that

all nonwhite alien immigrants from Africa and the West Indies were Negroes, and that all nonwhite alien immigrants from Asia and Oceania were of other races. It was also assumed that all non-white citizen arrivals were Negroes.

2. Net movement of citizens to and from overseas.--This category of immigration is estimated on the basis of the change in the number of civilian Federal employees overseas, their dependents, and dependents of Armed Forces overseas for July 1, 1966, to June 30, 1967, less births occurring in hospitals overseas operated by the Department of Defense. By age and sex, the estimates were based on data for July 1, 1965, to June 30, 1966. The data were obtained from the Department of Defense and the Civil Service Commission. Net movement of civilian citizens overseas not affiliated with the Federal Government is not taken into account.<sup>3</sup>

The Census count on April 1, 1960, was used as the basis for the percentage distribution by age, sex, and color, for each of the above listed categories of civilian citizens overseas. In the case of dependents of Armed Forces overseas, data by color for the Armed Forces overseas according to information from the Department of Defense were also used.

3. Net arrivals from Puerto Rico.--The data on the movement of persons between Puerto Rico and the United States mainland are based on the movement of passengers as reported by the Puerto Rico Planning Board. The age and sex distribution of these travelers is based on a sample survey taken by the Puerto Rico Bureau of Labor Statistics and released by the Division of Demographic Registry and Vital Statistics of the Puerto Rico Department of Health. All migrants from Puerto Rico were assumed to be white. Data through June 1967, were employed in preparing the estimates for 1968 given here.

4. Conditional entrants.--This category includes persons admitted conditionally from Cuba and Hong Kong, and "refugee-escapees" allowed in under the Act of July 14, 1960. After conditional entrants have lived in the United States for 2 years, they may be permitted to change their status to that of alien immigrant. Upon this change of status, an individual then is included in the published statistics of alien immigration. The

<sup>3</sup>The basic formula for estimating net movement of the overseas population involves subtracting natural increase, births less deaths, from total change in the overseas population. As the number of deaths was small, it was disregarded in the calculations.

double counting of conditional entrants is avoided by obtaining a net figure of conditional entrants admitted less conditional entrants who have changed status. Because a large proportion of this class of immigrants has come to Florida from Cuba, the age distribution for conditional entrants has been estimated from that of the population in Florida reported as living abroad 5 years earlier according to the 1960 Census.

Armed Forces.--To derive the estimates of the total resident and the civilian resident population, estimates were made of the total Armed Forces and of the Armed Forces overseas to be subtracted from the estimates of the total population including Armed Forces overseas. The estimates of the Armed Forces are based on data from the Statistical Service Center of the Department of Defense and from the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and, for the Coast Guard, from the Department of Transportation.<sup>4</sup> Reserve forces on a 6-month tour of training and students at the military academies are included in the Armed Forces; reserve forces on short tours of training, national guardsmen, and officers in the Public Health Service are not included. Crews of naval vessels in American ports are considered as being inside the United States; those in foreign ports or on the high seas are considered as being overseas. The total for each sex-color group for July 1, 1968, was distributed by age on the basis of data for January 1, 1968.

#### ANNUAL PROJECTIONS TO 1990 OF THE POPULATION AGED 16 YEARS AND OVER

The national projections of population are presented in detail in report No. 381 of this series. For the population aged 14 and over, annual figures are presented for all series. Subsequent to the preparation of this report, emphasis in labor force analysis was shifted from 14 years of age and over to 16 years and over. The detailed report provides data for the latter age group only for quinquennial dates.

The appendix table provides estimates and projections of the population aged 16 and over for each year, 1966 to 1990, for Series B, C, and D. Data for Series A, which assumes a very high birth rate are not given.

### ACCURACY OF ESTIMATES

The population estimates in this report have not been adjusted for underenumeration nor for misreporting of age in the 1960 Census data on which

they are based. Estimates for particular categories of the population may be understated because of underenumeration in the Census. Substantial work on evaluation of the 1960 Census by age, sex, and color has been carried out. Some of the results of the 1960 Census Evaluation and Research Programs have been published in Series ER-60 and in various special papers.<sup>5</sup>

### ROUNDING

Each figure in this report has been rounded independently to the nearest thousand from figures computed to the last digit; hence, the sum of parts may differ from the totals shown. Medians, percents, and other summary measures are based on the unrounded figures. The medians are based on data for 5-year age groups.
