

ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO JUNE 1, 1970

The total population of the United States (including Armed Forces overseas) was about 205,205,000 on June 1, 1970, according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase of 25,197,000, or 14.0 percent, since April 1, 1960, the date of the most recent census. There was an increase of 2,166,000, or 1.1 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago; and an increase of 182,000 over the previous month. The monthly gain was the result of a natural increase of 144,000 (excess of births over

deaths), and an estimated net civilian immigration of 39,000. (See chart below. Data are adjusted for number of days in the month, and are provisional after December 1967.)

This report presents estimates for (1) the total population including Armed Forces overseas, (2) the total resident population, and (3) the civilian resident population, for selected months back to January 1, 1950. These estimates agree with the figures published in Current Population Reports, Series P-25, No. 442,

which also presents data on the components of population change (births, deaths, and net immigration) for the period 1940 to 1969.

The estimates in this report are "census level" estimates in that no allowance is made for population not enumerated in the decennial censuses. In preparing the current estimates, the population counted on April 1, 1960, is brought forward by adding births, subtracting deaths, and adding net migration. Thus the estimated 5-1/2 million persons missed in the 1960 census are not included in the estimates. Comparisons of the 1970 census figures to be published later this year should take this factor into account.

In addition to data from the 1960 and 1950 censuses, the estimates are based on statistics on births and

deaths provided by the National Center for Statistics, U.S. Public Health Service; statistics on immigration and emigration provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice; data on civilian citizens abroad provided by the Department of Defense and the Civil Service Commission; data on movement between Puerto Rico and the United States mainland provided by the Puerto Rico Planning Board; and data on the Armed Forces provided by the Department of Defense. Provisional estimates of net civilian immigration since July 1, 1968, are based in part on immigrant visa statistics provided by the Bureau of Security and Consular Affairs, Department of State.
