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INVENTORY OF STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES PREPARING POPULATION ESTIMATES SURVEY OF 1969

(For previous surveys, see Current Population Reports, Series P-25, Nos. 328, 244, 178, and 116)

This report presents the results of a survey of the sources and types of current population estimates prepared by State and local (city, county, metropolitan, and regional) agencies. The survey was conducted by mail in December 1969 and January 1970. It is the fifth in a series of reports designed to provide a periodic inventory of the availability of population estimates from State and local government sources.

The Bureau of the Census now prepares current population estimates regularly for the United States as a whole, the States, the outlying areas of the United States, and 100 large metropolitan areas and their constituent counties.

With the establishment of the Federal-State Cooperative Program for Local Population Estimates (which will be explained in detail below) the Bureau has maintained a close association with the States in the area of current population estimates. For smaller areas, however, the survey provides the Bureau a means of keeping informed of efforts by local agencies in the field of population estimates. The Bureau is greatly interested in the availability of population estimates for all areas of the country. It has advised local agencies on methodology and has participated in the development and testing of various methods.

The survey covers States, counties, standard metropolitan statistical areas, and all cities expected to have 50,000 or more population in 1970.¹ A total of 55 State agencies and somewhat more than 400 local agencies were covered in the survey.

The 1969 survey represents an expansion of the coverage of the last survey in 1965, particularly with respect to local areas. State agency contacts were largely those involved in the Federal-State Cooperative Program, which includes participants from 47 States (see table 1).

City planning commissions, city and county health departments, chambers of commerce, and county and regional planning agencies were contacted where names and addresses of local agencies were known. In cases where the name of no agency was available, letters were sent to the mayor of

the city, requesting that he forward the questionnaire to the appropriate public agency in his community. Each contacted agency was informed of any other agencies being contacted in the survey that also prepared estimates for its particular area, and it was asked to report any additional organizations, unknown to the Bureau, which made population estimates for the area. These referrals were then also contacted. Local agencies with population estimates programs are listed in table 2.

The survey covers only the work of official State and local agencies; consequently, estimates made by private organizations and local agencies which use estimates from private sources, including consultants, are omitted. Where survey responses indicated that the only estimates made for an area are prepared by consultants, that area is listed in table 2 as "No estimates reported." Some exceptions have been made, however, in cases where a local Chamber of Commerce is the only area agency known to be making population estimates. Such agencies are included in table 2.

DETAILS OF THE SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE

The questionnaire asked for information on (1) the areas for which estimates are prepared (e.g., counties, cities, and census tracts) and (2) the characteristics for which estimates are prepared (e.g., age, sex, and color), as well as (3) a description of the methods used in preparing such estimates. When estimates were not prepared by census tract, respondents were asked if data were available from which census tract estimates could be made. Other questions related to frequency of publication of such estimates, the publication source, and whether unpublished figures were available to the public upon request. For purposes of this survey, the questionnaire category "color" may refer to either race or color. A copy of the questionnaire used in the survey is presented in appendix A of this report.

METHODS USED IN MAKING POPULATION ESTIMATES

The methods used by State agencies in making population estimates are summarized below in table A; methods used by local agencies are summarized in table E.

The survey questionnaire explicitly requested the name of agencies preparing population "estimates", and all questions pertained to estimates.

Nevertheless, a great many respondents supplied information concerning projections. For the purposes of this report we have tabulated only those agencies actually using one of the estimate techniques mentioned below. The 1965 survey did make a concerted effort to identify agencies having projections available.²

The following is a brief explanation of methods used in making population estimates. After interpreting the description of methodology on the respondents' questionnaires, each was classified according to one of the following categories:

Component or migration-and-natural-increase methods are those in which the components of population change since the last census--that is, births, deaths, and net migration--are estimated separately.

In Component Method II* of the Bureau of the Census, net migration is estimated on the basis of school enrollment or school census data from the difference between the actual population of elementary school age and the population of school age expected on the basis of the most recent census and births since the census. (In Component Method I of the Bureau of the Census, the net migration rate for a given area is estimated, on the basis of school enrollment or school census data, as the difference between the percent change in the population of school age for the area and the corresponding change for the United States.)

In other component methods, net migration is estimated in various other ways, such as the use of data on school enrollment for successive school years by grade (the grade-progression method), the use of the reported migration of previous decades, and other kinds of data, such as information on residential utility installations and dwelling units.

In the composite method*, estimates of various age groups are derived separately and are then summed to secure a total for all ages. One method is to use age-specific deaths and death rates;

another, developed by Bogue and Duncan,³ uses death statistics to estimate ages 45 and over, birth statistics to estimate ages 15 to 44 and under 5, and Component Method II (see above) to estimate ages 5 to 14 years. Other variations of the composite method employ other combinations of "indicators" for various age groups. These methods permit the choice of those indicators best suited to a given age range and provide some age detail as a by product.

In the censal ratio methods, current symptomatic data are multiplied by the ratio of population to the same symptomatic data at the last census for the area for which the estimate is being made. A variation of the method allows for a trend in this ratio between the census and the estimate date. Sometimes the initial estimates of population by the censal ratio method for the constituent parts of an area are adjusted so as to add to an independent estimate for the entire area. A censal ratio method may be simple, using one indicator, or complex using two or more indicators. The vital rates method⁴ is a ratio method in which two sets of estimates, based respectively on birth and death statistics, are averaged. The ratio-correlation method* is a censal ratio method in which the estimate is obtained by use of a formula for multiple regression between change in the proportion of the State's population in a county and the change in a number of censal ratios for the last decade. The housing unit method* is yet another censal ratio method, in which the estimates of population are based on estimates of dwelling units. The latter, in turn, are based on data on building permits issued, or on data on electric, gas, or water meter connections. In this method, allowance may or may not be made for the trend in the size of household in the area. Because of the lack of the necessary data to measure changes in the number of housing units for rural areas, the method is generally limited to urban areas.

The proration method involves the distribution of an estimated total for some large area among the constituent parts, as an independently estimated State total among counties, on the basis of the population at the last census or on the basis of current symptomatic data, such as school data,

births, or deaths. This procedure implicitly assumes that the State's population is currently distributed in the same proportion over the counties as at the last census, or that the ratio of population to the symptomatic item is the same for all of the counties. (In this respect, the proration method differs from the censal ratio method. In the latter the ratio of population to the symptomatic item is derived separately for each county.)

The natural increase method involves merely adding natural increase (births minus deaths) to the census figure. It assumes, therefore, that net migration since the last census equals zero.

ACTIVITY OF STATE AGENCIES

The Bureau of the Census, in recognition of the widespread need for small-area population estimates of uniform quality from State to State, has evolved over the last several years a cooperative program with the States for the preparation and publication of county population estimates.⁵ The ultimate objective of this Federal-State Cooperative Program is the development and regular publication of State-prepared county population figures, by preferred methods, largely standardized for data input and methods mutually agreed upon by the States and the Bureau of the Census. At this time 46 States are formal participants in the program, and one State has an informal commitment.⁶ The State agencies listed in table 1 that are participants in the Program are indicated as such with an asterisk. Co-op agencies omitted from table 1 are those which have no estimates presently available. A full list of all agencies participating in the Cooperative Program is shown in appendix B.

All participating agencies are committed to preparing county population estimates for 1970 as part of a test of methods against the 1970 census. Once the tests have been completed and evaluated, a procedure for developing county estimates will be agreed upon and a regular estimates program will be set up for the 1970's. Estimates for seven States have already been published by the Census Bureau in its Current Population Reports Series.⁷

In 1965 a total of 66 different State agencies making estimates were surveyed. Since the

institution of the Federal-State Cooperative Program, nearly all States have only one designated official estimating agency, which has resulted in the inclusion of only 55 State agencies in the current survey.⁸

In previous surveys, the State departments of health led all other statewide agencies in the preparation of local population estimates. In 1965, 27 out of 66 agencies listed in the survey were State departments of health, and another 21 were offices within State university systems. According to the 1969 survey results shown in table A, however, the leading contributors of population estimates are now State universities (17 States, commonly bureaus of business research or sociology departments), State planning and development agencies (14 States), and State departments of health (13 States). A category of agency concerned increasingly with estimates is the State budget, audit or finance office. State employment commissions are responsible for estimates in a few of the States. Three States, North Dakota, Rhode Island, and Delaware, reported no ongoing estimates program.

The majority of State agencies employ one method for preparing county estimates. Eighteen of the 55 agencies covered in this survey, however, used an average of two or more methods (see table B). In those States which used only one method, the most popular was some form of component method. Of increasing popularity is the ratio-correlation (or regression) method. In 1965 only three States used the ratio-correlation method; currently 18 agencies are using the method. The more common variables

used in the regression are vital statistics, school enrollment, tax returns, employment and auto registration. In 1965 five States used a composite method; currently that method is used by 15 State agencies. Part of the reason for the increased number of agencies using these methods is the increase in using an average of two or more

methods. In 1965 only four States averaged methods to reach a final estimate.

The Federal-State Cooperative Program has provided the incentive for several States to expand to programs of substantial complexity and sophistication with a considerable investment of staff.

ACTIVITY OF LOCAL AGENCIES

Types of agencies. Questionnaires were sent to 405 local agencies and mayors, including 355 original contacts and 50 referrals. Replies were received from 366 agencies. Of the 366, 241 (66 percent) prepared estimates. In 1965, 218 local agencies were contacted, of which 188 (54 percent) prepared estimates. The types of local agencies preparing estimates are shown in table C.

Areas and detail. Since the criterion for selecting a city was an estimated population of 50,000 in 1970 all of the agencies contacted were in actual or potential SMSA's. Of all the SMSA's contacted, 78 (34 percent) had no local agency reporting estimates. Of those agencies which responded, the majority prepared estimates for more than just a city. Some estimated the populations for all minor civil divisions in the SMSA or county, others for all cities in the SMSA or county, and so on. Ninety-

one of the agencies prepared estimates at the census tract level, and 92 others had data available by tracts from which population estimates could be prepared (table D). Building permit and demolition data and vital statistics are the most frequently mentioned as available for making tract estimates.

Methods used for estimating population. Classification of any of the methods used by local agencies is difficult because of the variability of the available data. Thus in every case possible in table 2 the source of the data is given in addition to the method used. For purposes of classification, however, it was necessary to generalize the various techniques and categorize them as to methodology. The methodologies given in table 2 are only the basic methods used by an agency; characteristics of the population such as age, color, or sex may be derived by a variation of the basic method which would not be specified in this report.

It is evident from table 2 that a large portion of the 241 agencies make estimates using more than one method. It is also evident that the housing unit method, a censal ratio method, is by far the most common means of making estimates, used by 178 of the 241 agencies (table E). The housing unit method includes many variations, again dependent on the symptomatic data available in the area. In addition to the utilization of construction data and utility connections, home interviews and land use surveys are used to develop a count of housing units. The degree of sophistication varies, too, in regard to the use of vacancy rates and persons per housing unit.

A component method was used by 44 agencies. Seventeen used the Bureau's Component Method II and the remainder used some other means of developing the migration component.

The next most popular method is the ratio-correlation, or regression method, also a censal ratio technique, used by 38 agencies. Most of the agencies using this technique used school enrollment, auto registrations and vital statistics as some of their variables.

The proration method was used by 11 agencies, mainly for smaller areas. The relatively unsophisticated natural increase method is still being used by 10 agencies.

A crude vital rates method and the composite method were each used by seven agencies. The composite method was generally used in combination with one or more other methods.

ACCURACY OF METHODS

The Bureau of the Census is keenly interested in the development of new data sources and improved methodology for the derivation of population estimates in local areas and has for some time participated in the development of estimates and in testing methodology.

As mentioned in the previous section on Activities of State Agencies, participants in the Federal-State Cooperative Program will be testing certain methods against the 1970 census. The results of the tests will be compiled and made available by the Bureau of the Census.

Past tests conducted by the Bureau of the Census and others provide information on the accuracy of various methods of preparing local estimates. Some of the more recent studies using the 1960 census as a standard are:

The aforementioned tests provide some indication of the general level of accuracy achieved in the past for selected methods for different kinds of areas. Substantial variation about the average has been found for specific areas.

OTHER SOURCES OF POPULATION ESTIMATES

In addition to the population estimates prepared and compiled by State and city agencies described above, local population figures are available from several other sources. These include special census counts made by the Bureau of the Census and estimates prepared by various private groups, including welfare agencies and marketing research organizations. The Bureau issues quarterly and annual summaries on results of special censuses in Current Population Reports, Series P-28. In addition, the current county estimates prepared by State agencies under the Cooperative Program will be available in Current Population Reports, Series P-26.
