




Population Estimates and Projections

ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO JUNE 1, 1972

The total population of the United States (including Armed Forces overseas) was about 208,698,000 on June 1, 1972 according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase 1,808,000, or 0.9 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago; and an increase of 140,000 over the previous month. The monthly gain was the result of a natural increase of 112,000 (excess of births over deaths), and an estimated net civilian immigration of 29,000. (See chart below. Data are adjusted for number of days in the month, and are provisional after December 1968.)

The June 1, 1972, total population represents an increase of 4,364,000 over the population on April 1, 1970, the date of the census upon which these estimates are based. Estimates for the period since April 1, 1960 have been adjusted to be consistent with the official 1970 resident population count of 203,235,298.¹

¹Previously published estimates for the period from April 1, 1960 to February 1, 1972 shown in Current Population Reports, Series P-25, No. 478 were consistent with an April 1, 1970 census count of 203,165,699 as shown in Advance Report, Series PC(V2)-1.



This report presents estimates for (1) the total population including Armed Forces overseas, (2) the total resident population, and (3) the civilian resident population, for selected months back to January 1, 1960. The population coverage shown by the Census Clock in the lobby of the Department of Commerce includes, in addition to the total population including Armed Forces overseas, overseas civilian employees of the Federal Government, their dependents, and the dependents of the Armed Forces overseas. On April 1, 1970, this population was 204,839,000.

In addition to data from the decennial censuses, the estimates are based on statistics on births and deaths provided by the National Center for Health

Statistics, U. S. Public Health Service; statistics on immigration provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice; data on civilian citizens abroad provided by the Department of Defense and the Civil Service Commission; data on movement between Puerto Rico and the United States mainland provided by the Puerto Rico Planning Board; and data on the Armed Forces provided by the Department of Defense. Provisional estimates of net civilian immigration since July 1, 1971, are based in part on immigrant visa statistics provided by the Bureau of Security and Consular Affairs, Department of State.
