

ESTIMATES OF THE POPULATION OF THE UNITED STATES TO SEPTEMBER 1, 1974

The total population of the United States (including Armed Forces overseas) was about 212,216,000, on September 1, 1974 according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase of 1,532,000, or 0.7 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago; and an increase of 155,000 over the previous month. The monthly gain was the result of a natural increase of 122,000 (excess of births over deaths), and estimated net civilian immigration of 33,000. (See chart below. Data are adjusted for number of days in the month.)

The September 1, 1974, total population represents an increase of 7,881,000 over the population on April 1, 1970, the date of the census upon which these estimates are based. Estimates for the period since April 1, 1960 have been adjusted to be consistent with the official 1970 resident population count of 203,235,298.

This report presents estimates for (1) the total population including Armed Forces overseas, (2) the resident population, and (3) the civilian population, for selected months back to January 1, 1960. The population coverage shown by the



Census Clock in the lobby of the Department of Commerce includes, in addition to the total population including Armed Forces overseas, overseas civilian employees of the Federal Government, their dependents, and the dependents of the Armed Forces overseas. On April 1, 1970, this population was 204,839,000.

In addition to data from the decennial censuses, the estimates are based on statistics on births and deaths provided by the National Center for Health Statistics, U.S. Public Health Service;

statistics on immigration provided by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice; data on civilian citizens abroad provided by the Department of Defense and the Civil Service Commission; data on movement between Puerto Rico and the United States mainland provided by the Puerto Rico Planning Board; and data on the Armed Forces provided by the Department of Defense.
