

Estimates of the Population of the United States to June 1, 1978

The total population of the United States (including Armed Forces overseas) was about 218,359,000 on June 1, 1978, according to estimates released today by the Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. This figure represents an increase of 1,688,000, or 0.8 percent, over the estimate for the corresponding month a year ago; and an increase of 144,000 over the previous month. The monthly gain was the result of a natural increase of 113,000 (excess of births over deaths), and estimated net civilian immigration of 31,000. (See chart below. Data are adjusted for number of days in the month.) The June 1, 1978, total

population represents an increase of 14,024,000 over the population on April 1, 1970, the date of the census upon which these estimates are based.

This report presents estimates for (1) the total population including Armed Forces overseas, (2) the resident population, and (3) the civilian population, for selected months back to January 1, 1970. The population coverage shown by the Census Clock in the lobby of the Department of Commerce includes, in addition to the total population including Armed Forces overseas, overseas civilian employees of the Federal Government, their dependents, and the
