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A Note on Interpreting the Charts

Because the data on centenarians in this report is based on a 2-percent sample, the use of point estimates may be misleading, as explained in the text. In the bar charts, estimates of characteristics of the centenarian population are presented as 90-percent confidence intervals. An explanation of the interpretation of confidence intervals is found in appendix C.

In all charts, the confidence interval is shown in diagonal stripes at the top of each bar for the data on centenarians. As an example, figure 2 shows the percentage of centenarians aged 100 to 104, and 105 and over, by sex. The correct interpretation of the first two bars is that between 88 and 93 percent of centenarians are aged 100 to 104, and between 7 and 12 percent are aged 105 and over, at the 90-percent confidence level. Point estimates are given for the 85-and-over population, as these data are taken from the full 1980 census sample detail file. The 90-percent confidence intervals are much more narrow for this age group, and are available in appendix A.

America's Centenarians

THE CENTENARIAN POPULATION

During the past century, average life expectancy at birth in the United States has increased 30 years. This represents a greater gain than during all of previous human history. Average life expectancy in 1985, the latest year for which data are available, was 71 years for men and 78 years for women.

Reflecting this increase in average life expectancy, as well as greater numbers of immigrants and births in the late 1800's, the Nation is experiencing a steady growth in the number of people aged 100 or more years. In 1980, the number of centenarians was approximately 15,000. By 1985, the number of centenarians had grown to about 25,000.¹ They are projected to number over 100,000 by the year 2000 (figure 1).²

The first surviving members of the post-World War II baby boom, those born from 1946 to 1964, will reach age 100 near the middle of the 21st century.



In the year 2080, the United States will have over 1 million centenarians if the assumptions underlying the Census Bureau's middle series of projections hold true. The uncertainty of future changes in mortality and immigration have led the Census Bureau to issue widely divergent series of projections for centenarians (future changes in fertility would not affect the number of centenarians until after 2080). For instance, if mortality is higher than assumed in the middle series of projections, there could be as few as half a million centenarians in 2080; lower mortality could lead to as many as 5 million centenarians.

The size of the centenarian population over the next 100 years will be affected greatly by immigration and societal, environmental, and medical impacts on life expectancy. Reduction in heart disease, progress against other fatal conditions such as strokes and certain forms of cancer, and better individual health practices such as improved diet, more exercise and reduction in smoking have already contributed to increases in the size of the older population.

Since 1950, the population 65 and over has more than doubled, the number of people 85 and over has increased almost five times, and the number of cente-

narians has grown more than ten times.³ While these growth rates are impressive, centenarians are still a very small percentage of the population. In 1986, centenarians constituted only about 1 in 10,000 persons in the total population, and 9 of every 10,000 elderly persons (65 and over). In 2080, there could be as many as 250 centenarians per 10,000 elderly people (middle series projections).

In the past, people rarely reached age 100, although the chances of living to that age have increased. For those born in 1879, the odds against living 100 years were 400 to 1; the chances for those born in 1874 of reaching age 105 were 2,904 to 1; and for those born in 1869, only one person in 27,823 lived to age 110.⁴ Compare these to the odds of people born in 1980 of reaching these ages (based on the mortality rates of the 1979-81 period): 87 to 1 for age 100, 559 to 1 for age 105, and 4,762 to 1 for age 110.⁵

Such large improvements suggest that the elderly population is itself aging. The Census Bureau's national projections also indicate this. For instance, those 85 and over are about 10 percent of the elderly (65 and over) population

now; by 2080, that proportion could rise to at least 25 percent. In fact, while the population 85 and over is projected to grow over sixfold from now to 2080 based on the middle series projections, centenarians would increase by a factor of 75!

The aging of the population as a whole is of interest to our society for a variety of reasons. Most people 65 and older are generally healthy and able to live normal, productive lives. As people live to very old ages, however, they encounter greater health risks and need for care.⁶ In addition, lengthening the time people live after retirement may affect the quantity of income and assets available to the oldest members of society. Centenarians are the most extreme example of these situations. It thus becomes important for society, families, and individuals to consider how to allocate resources to provide for the extremely long lives of this significant minority.

SOURCES OF DATA

Having placed the size and projected increase of the centenarian population in perspective, we now turn to a description of the characteristics of this select group. The decennial census is the only source of data on the socioeconomic characteristics of centenarians. For most of the following description, we used a 2-percent sample of living quarters containing centenarians from the 1980 Census of Population. (This file was developed by selecting 10 percent of the living quarters from the 1980 census sample detail

file. The sample detail file contains 20 percent of the total population.)

The data upon which most of this report draws are presented in appendix A. This table presents point estimates of the centenarian population, together with 90-percent confidence intervals around these estimates. These estimates were produced by inflating the 2-percent sample of centenarians by the appropriate sample weights. This is the first time the Census Bureau has provided estimates of the detailed sociodemographic characteristics of centenarians. The data have been edited to include only persons for whom age 100 or more was written on their census forms.⁷ Analysis has shown written age to be largely reliable, though there is still the possibility of age misreporting.⁸

To supplement these data, we have also used a second set of tabulations for the centenarian population from 1980 census special tabulations created under the sponsorship of the National Institute on Aging (NIA).⁹ Data for the United States and each State from this source are presented in appendix B. In the text, we use only data for respondents for whom age on the census form was written in or actually coded as 100 or

more. However, these data include more "false centenarians" because of persons who were incorrectly coded on the original census forms as centenarians, as well as possible overreporting of age for other reasons such as the lack of documentation of actual age. Persons who were assigned an age either because age was not indicated on their form, or because the age indicated was inconsistent with other information on their forms, were not included in the data used for the present paper unless noted otherwise.¹⁰

To provide a frame of reference, we will compare centenarians with the population aged 85 and over. Unless referenced otherwise, data for the latter age group are from the tabulations prepared for the National Institute on Aging, as described above.

RELIABILITY OF THE DATA

Because the data used in this paper were collected from a sample of the population, they are subject to sampling and nonsampling error. A technical statement about these types of errors and how to estimate the amount of statistical error is included in Appendix C, Source and Reliability of the Data.

Because of the small population and sample size discussed in the paper, point estimates could be misleading. To provide some sense of the range of the data and the relative differences among groups, data for the centenarian population are shown in confidence intervals at the 90-percent level. (Appendix B gives

confidence ranges for the 85 and older population as well.) For example, in the section below on age, sex, and race, the number of centenarians aged 100 to 104 is given as 12,400 to 13,200. The data allow a high degree of confidence that the true number of centenarians in this age group lies within this range, but the actual number is not known beyond this degree of accuracy. For some characteristics, the reported range is quite narrow, giving us quite a good idea of what the centenarian population is like in these particular respects. For those characteristics for which the range is broader, the reporting method used in this paper still allow an understanding of their general magnitude.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE CENTENARIAN POPULATION


Age, Sex, and Race

People who live beyond 99 years of age usually do so by only a few years. Most centenarians--12,400 to 13,200 (88 to 93 percent)--were less than 105 years old in 1980. Another 930 to 1,730 (7 to 12 percent) were aged 105 or more years (figure 2).

The centenarian population is predominantly female. There were 31 to 43 men per 100 women in the centenarian population in 1980 (figure 3). In this, the centenarian population is similar to the elderly population as a whole. There were about 44 men for every 100 women aged 85 and over, a ratio expected to continue into the next century barring drastic changes in relative mortality rates.


As in the general population, most centenarians are White. About 75 to 83 percent of those 100 and over in 1980 were White, slightly less than in the general population. Blacks, who constitute 12 percent of the gen-

eral population, represented 14 to 21 percent of centenarians. Three percent or less were American Indians, Eskimos, and Aleuts; 2 percent or less, Asian and Pacific Islanders; and 2 percent or less, persons of other races. Hispanics, who may be of any race, constituted 2 to 6 percent of the centenarian population.

There is some evidence that, at this extreme age, mortality rates for Blacks are not as high as for Whites.¹¹ In fact, 9 to 27 percent of Black centenarians were 105 and over, compared with only 4 to 10 percent of White centenarians. In contrast, Blacks constituted only 7 percent of the 85-and-over age group.

Blacks and Whites also show a difference in sex ratios at centenarian ages. Among Black centenarians, the ratio of males to females was higher than among White centenarians. There were 41 to 84 Black centenarian males per 100 Black females, compared with 24 to 37 White centenarian males per 100 females.

In summary, the age, sex, and race characteristics of centenarians generally follow the patterns observed at the younger old ages. The centenarians cluster within a few years of age 100, and the excess of females is more pronounced than among the population aged 85 to 99. Black-White differences were found in the centenarian population with respect to both relative survival rates and the sex ratio.

Living Arrangements and Marital Status

Of all centenarians, 45 to 55 percent lived in households with others or by themselves. The re-

mainder lived in group quarters, primarily in nursing homes (figure 4). Group quarters include all types of institutions, as well as rooming houses and other noninstitutional group living arrangements. Even at age 105 and over, only 26 to 56 percent lived in group quarters. Less than one-fourth of persons 85 and older were in group quarters.

Centenarian women tend to live in non-household settings more often than men. Over half (51 to 62 percent) of centenarian women but less than one-third (24 to 31 percent) of the men were in group living arrangements. Thus, the resulting group quarters centenarian population was about four-fifths female, not very different from the proportion of women among those 85 and over in group quarters; 5 to 14 percent of the centenarian women in group quarters, but virtually none of the men, were aged 105 or more.


Whites at advanced ages were more likely to live in group settings than older Blacks. Over half (52 to 63 percent) of White centenarians were living in group quarters, but less than one-third (14 to 33 percent) of Blacks (figure 5). As a result, the group quarters centenarian population was about 86 to 94 percent White and 4 to 12 percent Black. A higher proportion of Whites than Blacks 85 and over lived in group quarters as well, 25 percent versus 13 percent.¹² Among Hispanic centenarians, as many as two-fifths (39 percent or less) lived in group settings. We do not know if the dissimilar living arrangements are because of cultural or economic differences.

When one looks at the living arrangements of centenarians in households, we see that house-



hold relationships differed between the younger (aged 100 to 104) and older centenarians (aged 105 or more), and that centenarians differed even more sharply from the entire 85-and-older population in households. For example, 32 to 45 percent of centenarians in households were householders, i.e., their residences were owned or rented in their names, compared with two-thirds of those 85 and older who lived in households (figure 6).¹³

Black centenarians were represented among the household population to a greater degree than their proportion of centenarians as a whole. They were 14 to 21 percent of the centenarian population, but 20 to 33 percent of the population in households. Whites, who represent 75 to 83 percent of all centenarians, constituted only 61 to 74 percent of household centenarians.


Centenarians in households tend to live with their children more often than people 85 and over do; 29 to 42 percent of centenarians in households lived with their children. By contrast, about 15 percent of people 85 and older lived in their children's homes (figure 6).

It is interesting that centenarians in households are also more likely than people aged 85 and over to be living with people other than their immediate family (figure 6). Twelve to 22 percent of those aged 100 or more were "other relatives" (other than spouse, child, sibling or parent of the householder) in households, and 3 to 10 percent were nonrelatives. In comparison, only 12 percent of all people 85 and over in households were other relatives or nonrelatives.¹⁴


As to marital status, centenarians were largely a widowed group; between 76 and 84 percent of centenarians were widowed. As with the elderly in general, more centenarian women than men were widowed: 82 to 90 percent and 53 to 71 percent, respectively (figure 7). Widowhood increases with age. Among all persons 85 and over, 82 percent of women and 44 percent of men were widowed.¹⁵

Over one-fifth (20 to 37 percent) of centenarian men were married, compared with less than

sons 85 and older is that lower proportions of centenarians are householders or spouses of householders. Thus, higher proportions of centenarians are "other relatives" or nonrelatives of the householder.

one-tenth of the women (figure 8). These proportions reflect higher rates of widowhood with advancing age, as well as the tendency for men to remain married at more advanced ages than women. Nearly half of men, but only 8 percent of the women 85 and over were currently married.¹⁶ These married "pre-centenarians" were also much more likely to be living with their spouses in a household than were the currently married centenarians, as 30 percent lived in group quarters.

About the same proportion of centenarians in households and group quarters were widowed: 70 to 82 percent in households and 78 to 88 percent in group quarters; the difference is not statistically significant. Those in households were more likely to be

married than those in group quarters: 10 to 20 percent versus 3 to 9 percent. Those in institutions and other group settings were more likely to have never been married, 7 to 15 percent versus 1 to 7 percent in households.

In summary, the living arrangements and marital status of centenarians follow a profile typical of the total 85-and-older population. The pattern of increasing institutionalization and widowhood with age results in a centenarian population with higher proportions of both of these life conditions. At the same time, more centenarians live with their children.

Income and Poverty


Most centenarians reported very low incomes; 83 to 90 per-

cent had personal incomes of less than \$5,000, and only 1 to 4 percent reported receiving \$20,000 or more. The personal income of centenarian women tended to be lower than that of men: 88 to 94 percent of centenarian women received incomes less than \$5,000, compared with 65 to 81 percent of the men (figure 9).

A tabulation of poverty is not available for centenarians but is available for persons aged 95 and over.¹⁷ For all races combined, about 6,900 men and 15,500 women 95 and over were poor.



The poverty rate is not very different for men and women in this age group, 20 to 24 percent and 22 to 25 percent, respectively. Differences are more evident between Whites and Blacks. Poverty rates for Whites were 14 to 19 percent and 19 to 22 percent for males and females, respectively; the corresponding poverty rates for Black men and women were 36 to 47 percent and 33 to 41 percent.

While income for census purposes includes all sources of cash income such as Social Security, the data do not include information on the role of noncash sources such as food stamps or government payments to nursing homes.

Educational Attainment

Some research indicates that higher education is associated with greater longevity.¹⁸ However, over half (58 to 67 percent) of centenarians had an 8th grade education or less, including 5 to 10 percent who reported no schooling at all. Thirty-three to 45 percent had either completed (22 to 31 percent) or had some high school (8 to 14 percent). About 6 to 12 percent had some formal education beyond the 12th grade. Apparently, school attendance was not given much greater emphasis at least until the turn of the century, as the distribution by highest grade attended of all persons aged 85 years and over was similar to that of centenarians.¹⁹

Centenarian women tended to have more years of formal schooling than centenarian men (figure 10). Centenarian women were more likely to have attended up to the 12th grade (16 to 25 percent)

than were men (3 to 14 percent), while centenarian men were more apt to have stopped their education before 8th grade, 46 to 64 percent for men versus 26 to 36 percent of women. Only at the post-secondary level did men and women attend school in about the same proportions, 4 to 14 percent of men, and 6 to 12 percent of women.

Ancestry, Immigration, and Language Spoken

Most centenarians, 77 to 85 percent, were born in this country. About the same proportion of the entire 85-and-over population²⁰ were also born in the United States. Most of the centenarians born elsewhere immigrated to the

United States before 1950, and nearly all became naturalized citizens.


Many of the centenarians born outside the United States can speak English well or very well. Although about 12 to 19 percent of centenarians spoke a language other than English at home in 1980, 48 to 72 percent of these persons could speak English well or very well. Of those who speak a language other than English at home, a higher proportion of men than women speak English well (64 to 98 percent and 34 to 64 percent, respectively).

The dominant ancestry of the centenarian population is western European²¹ (40 to 50 percent). From 42 to 54 percent of cente-

narian women claimed western European origin, compared with 28 to 46 percent of the men. Twenty-four to 42 percent of the men were of Canadian or non-Spanish Caribbean ancestry, as were about one-fifth (17 to 27 percent) of the women. Small percentages of centenarians claimed ancestry from Eastern Europe and Russia (1 to 5 percent), and Hispanic ancestry from countries in North and South America and the Caribbean (1 to 4 percent). Two percent or less were of African ancestry.

In summary, in spite of the fact that they were born at a time of high immigration to the United States, most centenarians were native born. Most speak English as a native language, and of those who do not, most speak English well. The ancestry of centenarians reflects the ancestry of the general population, the majority having descended from western Europeans.

SUMMARY AND IMPLICATIONS

We are an aging society. An increasingly older, heterogeneous population is likely to become a reality in America. Centenarians are rare among the American population, but their numbers are increasing rapidly. As a group, their characteristics are similar to those of the population aged 85 and over, but the patterns are more pronounced. Centenarians, compared with people 85 and over,

are more likely to be women, living with someone other than a spouse, and living in institutional settings. Their incomes are lower, especially among women, and are more likely to be below the poverty level.

At the same time, centenarians are socially and economically diverse. Black centenarians are different from White centenarians in many respects. When compared with their respective proportions of the population in general, Blacks are found in the oldest class of centenarians, 105 years or more, to a greater degree than Whites. There is a higher proportion of men among Black centenarians than among White centenarians. Blacks are also less likely to be found in institutional settings, and they are more likely to be poor. Centenarians were found at all levels of educational attainment. Women tended to have attained a high school diploma more often than men.

The extension of life will probably result in ever larger numbers of economically and physically able very old people along with large numbers of chronically ill, dependent persons. Two major fears about such long lives are health and economic status. There are considerable differences among individuals in lifetime economic experiences, level of educational attainment, living arrangements, health practices, and so forth, all of which have implications for well-being to the individual and cost to society.

Catastrophic illnesses and illnesses of long duration are a significant economic threat, even to the aged with good economic resources, because they have little opportunity to replace their assets once they are spent.

As a consequence of the increasing numbers of very old people, the nature of American society will probably be vastly different 100 years from now as compared with today. While these demographic conditions represent only a few factors among many that will influence our future, there is certain to be rapid growth in the oldest-old population in general and the centenarian population in particular.

This report has shed light on several basic demographic and social characteristics of centenarians, and these data should provide a limited understanding of this burgeoning segment of the population. While the report shows what can be known about centenarians from available data, many aspects of this group can only be addressed by collecting a much fuller set of information. For example, more needs to be known about the health conditions and the full range of assets and economic resources available to the very old. Such information would allow a more informed assessment of the needs of the extremely old and provide a baseline by which to measure the magnitude of change in the future.

Appendix B. U.S. Summary and State Tables

DESCRIPTION OF DATA AND QUALITY OF THE DATA

Appendix B contains four tables of data on centenarians for the United States and for each State. The subjects of the tables were chosen because of the availability of data for this age group. The data are from the full 1980 census sample-detail file, and are affected by both nonsampling and sampling error.

Each table shows two distributions, one for ages "not allocated" and one for the total (labelled "allocated + not allocated" in the tables). The allocation process is a statistical procedure for the assignment of age to persons who did not indicate age on their census forms or whose stated ages were inconsistent with other information. The allocation procedure usually produces the highest quality data, but in the 1980 census, a problem in the allocation procedures resulted in an inflation of the count of the cen-

tenarian population by about one-fourth. Thus, the distribution labelled "allocated + not allocated" includes persons who are not centenarians. The extent and effect of this problem for the United States was detailed in a paper by Gregory Spencer.¹ For States, the extent of the error caused by the allocation procedures is indicated by the distribution labelled "not allocated." Unallocated age data are still subject to other nonsampling error, however, as some persons may have been incorrectly coded on the original census forms as centenarians, or they may have overreported their ages because of incomplete documentation of actual age or for other reasons.

Both distributions are also subject to sampling error (compute standard errors from the formulas in appendix C before

using the data in the following tables for the United States and States). The 1980 census sample estimate of centenarians is about 29,000 (labelled "allocated + not allocated" in tables), compared with the complete count figure of about 32,000. The sample estimate of centenarians adjusted to remove the allocation error is about 22,000 (labelled "not allocated" in tables) and is subject to sampling and nonsampling error.

The effect of other nonsampling error could not be shown in these tables. Spencer's analysis and administrative records from the Social Security Administration indicate the actual count of centenarians in 1980 should have been about 15,000. The extent of nonsampling errors for individual States is not determined. The "not allocated" distribution is the best estimate of the centenarian population that can be provided for each State, but it still represents an inflation of the true count of centenarians.

Appendix C. Sources and Reliability of Data

The data used in this publication were derived from the 1980 census sample detail file. This file includes information for approximately 20 percent of the Nation's housing units. Two sampling rates were employed in its creation. In all counties, incorporated places, and minor civil divisions that were estimated to have fewer than 2,500 persons (based on pre-census estimates), one-half of all housing units and persons in group quarters were to be included in the sample. In all other places, one-sixth of the housing units or persons in group quarters were sampled. The purpose of this scheme was to provide relatively more reliable estimates for small places.

TWO-PERCENT SAMPLE

All of the national-level centenarian data described in the text are based upon a 10-percent random sample of the households and group quarters containing one or more centenarians in the sample detail file. The centenarians in these sample housing units therefore constituted a 2-percent sample of the centenarians enumerated in 1980.

Photocopies of the original census forms for these 621 cases were obtained from the Census Bureau's Jeffersonville, Indiana, processing office. Examination of these forms resulted in the reduction of the sample to 271 cases. The other cases were eliminated either because they were clearly not centenarians, or because no age data whatsoever was on the original form, or because their census forms were incompletely copied.

The estimated value for each characteristic derived from this file was obtained by summing the weights assigned to the centenarians who possessed that characteristic. The weight for each centenarian is the product of the 1980 census weight and a factor computed at the state level. This factor is the ratio of the sum of the 1980 census weights of all centenarians on 1980 census long forms in a given State to the sum of the 1980 census weights of all centenarians in the 2-percent sample in the given State. These estimates are shown in appendix A.

"UNALLOCATED" CENTENARIAN SAMPLE

All the State-level centenarian estimates, as well as all the national data for "unallocated" centenarians were derived from the complete sample detail file. The only modification was to exclude those centenarians who had been "allocated" an age, about 25 percent of all centenarians in the sample. The "allocated" centenarians were those persons with no acceptable age coded on the 1980 census questionnaire for whom the 1980 edit procedures created an age of 100 and over. The point estimates developed from unallocated centenarian data are not fully consistent with those derived from the previous 2 percent sample. The reason is that some of the unallocated (as well as all the allocated) centenarians were removed from that file. They were excluded even though their coded age was over 100 because

other evidence on the form showed their correct age to be younger.

The data for the 85 and over population were directly drawn from the complete sample detail file. No adjustments were made to these point estimates.

LIMITATIONS OF THE DATA

The numbers in this report are estimates of the actual figures that would have resulted from a complete census count. Estimates based on sample data can be expected to vary from the complete count result because they are subject to two basic types of error—sampling and nonsampling. The sampling error in the data arises from the selection of persons and housing units to be included in the sample. The nonsampling error is the result of all other errors that may occur during the collection and processing phases of the census. More detailed discussions of both sorts of error are available in 1980 census volumes.

CONFIDENCE INTERVALS

A sample estimate and its estimated standard error can be used to construct confidence intervals about the estimate. These intervals are ranges with a known probability that would include the average result of all possible samples. For example, the results in this paper are provided by use of a 90-percent confidence interval. This means that if all possible samples were independently selected, and each of these were surveyed under essentially the same general conditions and using

the same sample design, and if an estimate and its standard error were calculated from each sample, then approximately 90 percent of the intervals from 1.6 standard errors below the estimate to 1.6 standard errors above the estimate would include the average results of all possible samples.

STANDARD ERRORS

The calculation of the standard errors from which these confidence intervals were derived is described in this section.

1. The approximate standard error (se) of an estimated number of persons with a particular characteristic (x) is:

$$se(\hat{x}) = 49 * \hat{x} * (1 - \hat{x}/n)$$

where:

n is the number of centenarians in the U.S., and

\hat{x} is the estimated number of centenarians with characteristic x.

2. The approximate standard error of a sample percentage (\hat{x}/\hat{y}) is:

$$se(\hat{x}/\hat{y}) = \frac{(49/\hat{y}) * (\hat{x}/\hat{y}) * (1 - \hat{x}/\hat{y})}{\hat{y}}$$

where:

\hat{x} is the estimate in the numerator of the percentage and \hat{y} is the estimate in the denominator of the percentage.
