POPULATION OF INDIANA: APRIL 1, 1950

(This is one of a series of reports presenting final population figures for selected areas in each State. In this series, reports are numbered alphabetically by States. Additional reports will be issued as final figures for other States become available)

The total population of Indiana on April 1, 1950, was 3,934,224, according to final figures for the State released today by Roy V. Peel, Director, Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. During the previous 10 years, the population of the State increased by 506,428, or 14.8 percent, over the 3,427,796 inhabitants enumerated in 1940. Among the States, Indiana ranked twelfth in population. The 1950 population was almost 27 times as large as its population in 1820 when it was first enumerated as a State.

According to the new urban definition, Indiana had 2,357,196 persons living in urban territory and 1,577,028 persons in rural territory. The urban population amounted to 59.9 percent of the total population of the State.

Between 1940 and 1950, 74 of the 92 counties in Indiana gained population and 18 lost population. Almost one-half of the population increase in the State was accounted for by Marion, Lake, St. Joseph, and Vanderburgh Counties; four of the most populous counties in the State. Clark experienced the greatest rate of increase, 55.8 percent. The counties of Indiana ranged in size from Ohio with a population of 4,223 to Marion with a population of 551,777.

In 1950 Indiana had a total of 537 incorporated places and 12 unincorporated places of 1,000 inhabitants or more. The incorporated places ranged in size from Shores Acres town with a population of 9 to Indianapolis city with a population of 427,173. There were 2,534,710 persons living in the incorporated places, 317,242 of whom were in the 421 places of fewer than 2,500 inhabitants. Of the 24,979 persons in the

unincorporated places, 14,216 were living in the 9 places of 1,000 to 2,500 inhabitants.

Under the urban definition established for use in the 1950 Census, the urban population comprises all persons living in (a) places of 2,500 inhabitants or more incorporated as cities, boroughs, towns,¹ and villages; (b) the densely settled urban fringe, including both incorporated areas, around cities of 50,000 or more; and (c) unincorporated places of 2,500 inhabitants or more outside any urban fringe. The remaining population is classified as rural. According to the urban definition used in previous censuses, the urban population comprised all persons living in incorporated places of 2,500 inhabitants or more and areas (usually minor civil divisions) classified as urban under special rules relating to population size and density.

In both definitions, the most important component of the urban territory is the group of incorporated places having 2,500 inhabitants or more. A definition of urban territory restricted to such places, however, would exclude a number of equally large and densely settled places, merely because they were not incorporated places. Under the old definition, an effort was made to avoid some of the more obvious omissions by the inclusion of the places urban under special rules. Even with these rules, however, many large and closely built-up places were excluded from the urban territory. To improve the situation in the 1950 Census, the Bureau of the Census

set up, in advance of enumeration, boundaries for urban-fringe areas around cities of 50,000 or more and for unincorporated places outside urban fringes. All the population residing in urban-fringe areas and in unincorporated places of 2,500 or more is classified as urban according to the 1950 definition. (Of course, the incorporated places of 2,500 or more are urban in their own right.) Consequently, the special rules of the old definition are no longer necessary.

According to the new urban definition, the 1950 urban population of Indiana included the following components: (1) The 2,217,468 inhabitants of the 116 incorporated places of 2,500

or more; (2) the 10,763 inhabitants of the 3 specially delineated unincorporated places of 2,500 or more; and (3) the 128,965 persons living in other territory included in the urban-fringe areas of Evansville, Terre Haute, Fort Wayne, Indianapolis, and in the Indiana parts of the urban-fringe areas of Chicago, Ill.; Louisville, Ky.; and South Bend, Ind. Since there were no places urban under special rule in Indiana according to the old definition, the population of the first element comprised the urban population under the old definition. The population of the remaining elements--139,728--represents the gain in the urban population of Indiana which resulted from the change in definition.

POPULATION OF INDIANA: APRIL 1, 1950

(This is one of a series of reports presenting final population figures for selected areas in each State. In this series, reports are numbered alphabetically by States. Additional reports will be issued; as final figures for other States become available. Star (*) denotes revised figure; see table 4)

The total population of Indiana on April 1, 1950, was 3,934,224, according to final figures for the State released today by Roy V. Peel, Director, Bureau of the Census, Department of Commerce. During the previous 10 years, the population of the State increased by 506,428, or 14.8 percent, over the 3,427,796 inhabitants enumerated in 1940. Among the States, Indiana ranked twelfth in population. The 1950 population was almost 27 times as large as its population in 1820 when it was first enumerated as a State.

According to the new urban definition, Indiana had 2,357,196 persons living in urban territory and 1,577,028 persons in rural territory. The urban population amounted to 59.9 percent of the total population of the State.

Between 1940 and 1950, 74 of the 92 counties in Indiana gained population and 18 lost population. Almost one-half of the population increase in the State was accounted for by Marion, Lake, St. Joseph, and Vanderburgh Counties, four of the most populous counties in the State. Clark experienced the greatest rate of increase, 55.8 percent. The counties of Indiana ranged in size from Ohio with a population of 4,223 to Marion with a population of 551,777.

In 1950 Indiana had a total of 537 incorporated places and 12 unincorporated places of 1,000 inhabitants or more. The incorporated places ranged in size from Shores Acres town with a population of 9 to Indianapolis city with a population of 427,173. There were 2,534,710 persons living in the incorporated places, 317,242 of whom were in the 421 places of fewer than 2,500 inhabitants. Of the 24,979 persons in the

unincorporated places, 14,216 were living in the 9 places of 1,000 to 2,500 inhabitants.

Under the urban definition established for use in the 1950 Census, the urban population comprises all persons living in (a) places of 2,500 inhabitants or more incorporated as cities, boroughs, towns,¹ and villages; (b) the densely settled urban fringe, including both incorporated areas, around cities of 50,000 or more; and (c) unincorporated places of 2,500 inhabitants or more outside any urban fringe. The remaining population is classified as rural. According to the urban definition used in previous censuses, the urban population comprised all persons living in incorporated places of 2,500 inhabitants or more and areas (usually minor civil divisions) classified as urban under special rules relating to population size and density.

In both definitions, the most important component of the urban territory is the group of incorporated places having 2,500 inhabitants or more. A definition of urban territory restricted to such places, however, would exclude a number of equally large and densely settled places, merely because they were not incorporated places. Under the old definition, an effort was made to avoid some of the more obvious omissions by the inclusion of the places urban under special rules. Even with these rules, however, many large and closely built-up places were excluded from the urban territory. To improve the situation in the 1950 Census, the Bureau of the Census

¹ Except in New England, New York, and Wisconsin, where "towns" are minor civil divisions of counties and are not necessarily densely settled centers like the towns in other States.

set up, in advance of enumeration, boundaries for urban-fringe areas around cities of 50,000 or more and for unincorporated places outside urban fringes. All the population residing in urban-fringe areas and in unincorporated places of 2,500 or more is classified as urban according to the 1950 definition. (Of course, the incorporated places of 2,500 or more are urban in their own right.) Consequently, the special rules of the old definition are no longer necessary.

According to the new urban definition, the 1950 urban population of Indiana included the following components: (1) The 2,217,468 inhabitants of the 116 incorporated places of 2,500

or more; (2) the 10,763 inhabitants of the 3 specially delineated unincorporated places of 2,500 or more; and (3) the 128,965 persons living in other territory included in the urban-fringe areas of Evansville, Terre Haute, Fort Wayne, Indianapolis, and in the Indiana parts of the urban-fringe areas of Chicago, Ill.; Louisville, Ky.; and South Bend, Ind. Since there were no places urban under special rule in Indiana according to the old definition, the population of the first element comprised the urban population under the old definition. The population of the remaining elements--139,728--represents the gain in the urban population of Indiana which resulted from the change in definition.
