SIR:

I transmit herewith Volume II of the Fifteenth Census Reports on Population. This volume comprises 14 chapters, each presenting the statistics of population for one subject or group of related subjects, for the United States, by States, with figures for the more important cities—usually cities of 25,000 inhabitants or more—and for urban, rural-farm, and rural-nonfarm areas. Some of the subjects which appear in this volume, like State of birth of the native population and mother tongue of the foreign-born white population, are not referred to in any of the other volumes of the Fifteenth Census Reports. Other subjects, like age distribution and marital condition, are presented here in much greater detail than in Volume III, where condensed statistics are given State by State.

The census of population was taken as of April 1, 1930, in conformity with the act providing for the Fifteenth Census and for the apportionment of Representatives in Congress, approved June 18, 1929. The results of the census of population are contained in six volumes, as follows: Volume I, Number and Distribution of Inhabitants; Volume II, General Report—Statistics by Subjects; Volume III, Reports by States, Showing the Composition and Characteristics of the Population for Counties, Cities, and Townships or Other Minor Civil Divisions; Volume IV, Occupations, by States; Volume V, General Report on Occupations; Volume VI, Families. The results of the census of unemployment, which was taken in conjunction with the census of population, are contained in two volumes, as follows: Volume I, Unemployment Returns by Classes for States, Counties, and Cities; Volume II, General Report on Unemployment.

The collection and compilation of the statistics of population and unemployment, including the preparation of this volume, were under the supervision of Dr. Leon E. Truesdell, chief statistician for population, assisted by Olive M. Riddleberger, assistant chief statistician.
