LETTER OF TRANSMITTAL

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE,

Washington, D. C., December 11, 1937.

SIR: I transmit herewith the report of the eighth biennial census of manufactures. This census, which was taken in 1936 under authority of section 17 of the act providing for the fifteenth and subsequent decennial censuses, approved June 18, 1929, covered manufacturing operations during the calendar year 1935. The results were first published in the form of mimeographed and multilithed preliminary reports (approximately 1,000 in number) for industries and for States and cities; and later the final reports for industries were issued as printed pamphlets, the contents of which have been assembled to constitute Chapter III of the present volume.

The canvass was made under the supervision of E. K. Ellsworth, Chief, Field Division, and the statistics were compiled and published under the supervision of LeVerne Beales, Chief Statistician for Manufactures, assisted by John F. Daly, Assistant Chief Statistician.

The cooperation of manufacturers' associations, chambers of commerce, boards of trade, and similar organizations in the collection of the data in the field is acknowledged.
