#### Group 1.—FOOD AND KINDRED PRODUCTS

##### Added:

*Liquors, distilled, and ethyl alcohol.*—Transferred from Group 6.

*Liquors, malt.*—Restored; used prior to 1923.

*Liquors, vinous.*—Transferred from Group 6.

##### Abandoned:

*Coffee and spices, roasting and grinding.*

*Peanuts, walnuts, and other nuts, processed or shelled.*

#### Group 3.—FOREST PRODUCTS

##### Transferred to Group 13:

*Refrigerators and refrigerator cabinets, exclusive of mechanical refrigerating equipment; combined with Refrigerators, mechanical Group 13; new title, Refrigerators and refrigerating and ice-making apparatus.*

#### Group 6.—CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS

##### Transferred to Group 1:

*Alcohol, ethyl, and distilled liquors.*—Title changed to *Liquors, distilled, and ethyl alcohol.*

*Liquors, vinous.*

#### Group 13.—MACHINERY, NOT INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION EQUIPMENT

##### Combined with industry in Group 3:

*Refrigerators and refrigerating and ice-making equipment.* Combination of *Refrigerators, mechanical*, formerly a separate industry classification in this group, and *Refrigerators and refrigerator cabinets, exclusive of mechanical refrigerating equipment*, formerly a separate industry classification in Group 3.

## INDUSTRY CHANGES, BY GROUPS

**Group 1.—FOOD AND KINDRED PRODUCTS**

*Beverages.*—Title changed to *Beverages, nonalcoholic.*

*Canning and preserving: Fish, crabs, shrimps, oysters, and clams.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Canned and preserved fish, crabs, shrimps, oysters, and clams.*

*Canning and preserving: Fruits and vegetables; pickles, jellies, preserves, and sauces.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Canned and dried fruits and vegetables; preserves, jellies, fruit butters, pickles, and sauces.*

*Coffee and spices, roasting and grinding.*—Abandoned as a manufacturing industry at census for 1933.

*Liquors, distilled, and ethyl alcohol.*—Formerly *Alcohol, ethyl, and distilled liquors*, no. 601, Group 6. Transferred to Group 1, no. 134.

*Liquors, malt.*—Restored industry classification; used at censuses prior to 1923.

*Liquors, vinous.*—Transferred from Group 6, no. 620, to Group 1, no. 135.

*Peanuts, walnuts, and other nuts, processed or shelled.*—Abandoned as a manufacturing industry at census for 1933.

**Group 2.—TEXTILES AND THEIR PRODUCTS**

*Flax and hemp, dressed.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of reports for 1931, abandoned as a manufacturing industry; treated as a quasi-agricultural activity.

*Silk and rayon manufactures.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of report for 1931, title changed to *Silk and rayon goods.*

**Group 3.—FOREST PRODUCTS**

*Refrigerators and refrigerator cabinets, exclusive of mechanical refrigerating equipment.*—Combined with *Refrigerators, mechanical*, no. 1310, Group 13, and title changed to *Refrigerators and refrigerating and ice-making apparatus.*

**Group 4.—PAPER AND ALLIED PRODUCTS**

*Labels and tags.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of reports for 1931, abandoned as a separate industry classification. Establishments formerly assigned to this industry are now classified in no. 503, 506, or 508 in Group 5 or in no. 1612 in Group 15, according to kind of labels and tags produced.

**Group 5.—PRINTING, PUBLISHING, AND ALLIED INDUSTRIES**

*Engraving, steel and copperplate, and plate printing.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, combined with *Engraving, wood*, formerly a separate classification, and title changed to *Engraving, steel, copperplate, and wood, and plate printing.*

*Engraving, wood.*—Abandoned as a separate classification. See "*Engraving, steel, copperplate,*" etc., above.

*Printing and publishing, book and job.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, expanded to cover printed labels and tags, formerly included in abandoned classification *Labels and tags.* See *Labels and tags*, Group 4, above.

**Group 6.—CHEMICALS AND ALLIED PRODUCTS**

*Alcohol, ethyl, and distilled liquors.*—Title changed to *Liquors, distilled, and ethyl alcohol* and transferred to group 1, no. 134.

*Liquors, vinous.*—Transferred to Group 1 and numbered 135.

## INDUSTRY CHANGES, BY GROUPS—Continued

**Group 7.—PRODUCTS OF PETROLEUM AND COAL**

*Coke, not including gas-house coke.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Coke-oven products*.  
*Coke-oven products.*—See above.

*Fuel: Briquettes.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Fuel briquettes*.

**Group 8.—RUBBER PRODUCTS**

No change.

**Group 9.—LEATHER AND ITS MANUFACTURES**

*Saddlery and harness.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, combined with *Whips*, formerly a separate industry classification in Group 16, and title changed to *Saddlery, harness, and whips*.

**Group 10.—STONE, CLAY, AND GLASS PRODUCTS**

*Wall plaster, wall board, insulating board, and floor composition.*—Title changed to *Wall board, insulating board, gypsum and other plasters, and floor composition*.

**Group 11.—IRON AND STEEL AND THEIR PRODUCTS, NOT INCLUDING MACHINERY**

*Blast furnaces.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Blast-furnace products*.

*Steel works and rolling mills.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Steel-works and rolling-mill products*.

*Wire, drawn from purchased bars or rods.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Wire drawn from purchased rods*.

**Group 12.—NONFERROUS METALS AND THEIR PRODUCTS**

*Clocks, watches, and materials and parts, except watchcases; time-recording devices and time stamps.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Clocks, watches, time-recording devices, and materials and parts except watchcases*.

*Copper, tin, and sheet-iron work, including galvanized-iron work, not elsewhere classified.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Sheet-metal work, not specifically classified*.

*Gold, silver, and platinum, reducing and refining, not from the ore.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Gold, silver, and platinum, refining and alloying*.

*Nonferrous-metal alloys and products, not including aluminum products.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Nonferrous-metal alloys; nonferrous-metal products, except aluminum, not elsewhere classified*.

*Sheet-metal work, not specifically classified.*—See *Copper, tin, and sheet-iron work, including galvanized-iron work, not elsewhere classified*, above.

*Smelting and refining, metals other than gold, silver, or platinum, not from the ore.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Smelting and refining, nonferrous metals other than gold, silver, and platinum, not from the ore*.

**Group 13.—MACHINERY, NOT INCLUDING TRANSPORTATION EQUIPMENT**

*Cash registers, adding machines, and calculating machines.*—Title incorrectly published in Industry Classifications for 1931. Correct title: *Cash registers and adding, calculating, and card-tabulating machines*.

## Group 13.—MACHINERY—Continued.

*Gas machines, gas meters, and water and other liquid meters.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Meters (gas, water, etc.) and gas generators*.

*Meters (gas, water, etc.) and gas generators.*—See *Gas machines, gas meters, etc.*, above.

*Refrigerators, mechanical.*—Combined with *Refrigerators and refrigerator cabinets, exclusive of mechanical refrigerating equipment*, no. 316, Group 3, and title changed to *Refrigerators and refrigerating and ice-making apparatus*.

*Refrigerators and refrigerating and ice-making apparatus.*—See *Refrigerators, mechanical*.

## Group 14.—TRANSPORTATION EQUIPMENT, AIR, LAND, AND WATER

*Carriage, wagon, sleigh, and sled materials, made for sale as such.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, abandoned as a separate industry classification. Hubs, spokes, felloes, etc., are included in *Wood turned and shaped and other wooden goods, not elsewhere classified*, Group 3, and assembled parts, such as wheels, are included in *Carriages, wagons, sleighs, and sleds*, Group 14.

## Group 15.—RAILROAD REPAIR SHOPS

*Car and general construction and repairs, electric-railroad repair shops.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Railroad repair shops, electric*.

*Car and general construction and repairs, steam-railroad repair shops.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Railroad repair shops, steam*.

## Group 16.—MISCELLANEOUS INDUSTRIES

*Fancy and miscellaneous articles, not elsewhere classified.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 reports, combined with *Ivory, shell, and bone work, not including buttons, combs, or hairpins*, formerly a separate industry classification, and title changed to *Miscellaneous articles not elsewhere classified*.

*Furs, dressed.*—Title changed to *Furs, dressed and dyed*.

*Ivory, shell, and bone work, not including buttons, combs, or hairpins.*—See *Fancy and miscellaneous articles, not elsewhere classified*, above.

*Miscellaneous articles not elsewhere classified.*—Revised title. See *Fancy and miscellaneous articles, not elsewhere classified*, above.

*Motion pictures, not including projection in theaters.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, abandoned as a manufacturing industry. Now treated as a "Special Inquiry."

*Paving materials: Asphalt, tar, crushed slag, and mixtures.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report, title changed to *Paving materials: Blocks (except brick and stone) and mixtures*.

*Soda-water apparatus.*—Title changed to *Soda fountains and accessories*.

*Soda fountains and accessories.*—See above.

*Whips.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of report for 1931, combined with *Saddlery and harness*, Group 9, and title changed to *Saddlery, harness, and whips*.

*Dyeing and cleaning establishments.*—After publication of 1931 Industry Classifications but before publication of 1931 report for this special inquiry, title changed to *Dry cleaning and re-dyeing establishments*. For 1933, changed to *Cleaning and dyeing establishments*.
