PRELIMINARY REPORTS

SERIES HC-1 TO HC-5

Preliminary results of the 1950 Census of Housing were published in a series of reports, HC-1, HC-2, HC-3, HC-4, and HC-5. The data were based either on preliminary field counts or preliminary sample tabulations. The reports were not issued as a single publication. This special binding contains all the publications issued in these series, arranged according to the number of the report.

In Series HC-1, a report was issued for each State showing preliminary counts of dwelling units (by counties and places of 5,000 inhabitants or more) based on tabulations made in the field. Series HC-2 is the comparable series for the Territories and possessions included in the Census of Housing.

Series HC-3, HC-4, and HC-5 are preliminary reports on selected housing characteristics, based on tabulations of samples of dwelling units. The HC-3 reports are for the 57 standard metropolitan areas having a population of 250,000 or more in 1940. The HC-4 reports are for the 10 States with the largest population in 1940, and for Hawaii and Puerto Rico. The HC-5 reports are for the United States, for the four regions, and for the 57 standard metropolitan areas summarized.
