TYPE OF FILE

Geographic reference.

SUBJECT-MATTER DESCRIPTION:

This file indicates the correspondence between congressional districts (CD's) of the 99th U.S. Congress and 1980 census geographic areas. Each record contains a 2-digit congressional district code. State and county records are always shown. Where counties are split by CD's, lower levels of geography (MCD/CCD, place, census tract, block group, block, and enumeration district) are shown as required.

GEOGRAPHIC COVERAGE:

U.S. Congressional Districts.

FILE STRUCTURE: Rectangular.

FILE SORT: Records are sequenced in their census geographic hierarchical order.

FILE SIZE: 43,564 logical records; 80- character logical record length.

FILE DESCRIPTION:

This file contains records for the fifty states and the District of Columbia. Of this group, ten states were redistricted for the 99th Congress: California, Hawaii, Louisiana, Maine, Mississippi, Montana, New Jersey, New York, Texas, and Washington.

As a result of redistricting, the data for these ten states are revised from that contained in the 98th Congress CD Equivalency File. Data for the other forty states and the District of Columbia remain unchanged.

The record layout and data definitions are identical to the 98th Congress CD Equivalency File. There are, however, revisions to Attachment 5 of that technical documentation. The revisions are in Attachment 2 entitled "Census Blocks Split by Congressional District (CD) Boundaries of the 99th Congress and Allocated to One Congressional District."

REFERENCE MATERIALS:

The Congressional District Equivalency File is comprised of 8 types of records (see "record type" field description below). All records have the same length and are sequenced in an hierarchical order of census geography. Character positions 31-66 contain geographic area names for record types S, C, M, P; and census tract/BNA, block group, block and enumeration district numbers for record types T, K, B, and E (see attachment 3 for an example of the file sequence).
