



## Neighborhood Assets

### 42%

of households agree "This neighborhood has good bus, subway or commuter bus service."

### 9%

of households agree "This neighborhood has a lot of serious crime."

### 87%

of households agree "This neighborhood has good schools."

### 36%

of households report that it is important to live near arts and cultural events

89% of these households are satisfied with the arts and cultural events in their neighborhood



## Housing Quality



6% of households live in inadequate housing

746,700 households have made some home improvement in past 2 years



3% of households report their water is not safe to drink

34% of these households cite energy efficiency as a reason for improvements



14% of households have tobacco smoke inside the home daily

7% of households cite accessibility for elderly or disabled persons as a reason for improvements

## Housing Costs

25,100 households received housing counseling

92% reported that their housing counseling was helpful

\$823 was the median monthly cost of housing

17% of households pay at least half their monthly income for housing



\$1,200 was the median expenditure on home improvement projects in past 2 years

39% of these households report food insecurity in the past 30 days
