



2020 CENSUS TRIBAL CONSULTATIONS NATIONAL WEBINAR

The U.S. Census Bureau is hosting a 2020 Census Tribal Consultation national webinar to be conducted in two half-day sessions with the 566 federally recognized tribes across the country as part of our ongoing effort to improve our government-to-government relations with tribes. Each day will have updates and discussions on different topics related to the 2020 Census.

This webinar will provide a forum for tribes to share insights, make recommendations, and discuss concerns related to the 2020 Census and other Census-related programs.
