Why work for Census?

- Offers temporary employment opportunities with good compensation, flexible work schedules, and on-the-job training
- Ideal for people who want to work close to home, are between jobs, or want to earn extra money while helping their communities



Developing Skills

- Solving problems
- Making informed decisions
- Organizing tasks
- Reading online maps
- Using hand-held devices (smartphones, tablets)



How Can Tribal Governments Help?

- Assisting with recruiting efforts through tribal employment organizations
- Providing access to allow applicants to apply online
- Providing space for training
- Providing a point of contact between the Census Bureau and tribal members
