FROM THE U.S. CENSUS BUREAU

Last month, we sent you an Annual Accommodation or Food Services Report form. Our records show we have not yet received your completed form. **You may disregard this notice if you have recently mailed your report.**

We are writing again to stress the importance of your firm's response to our report. It is only through the cooperation of every business in our sample that the results are accurate and truly representative.

Enclosed is an additional copy of the report form for your convenience. We request that you **complete the report within the next three business days**. If you wish to report online using our secure Web site, your username and password as well as the Web site address are located on the form beneath the address label. You may also fax this form toll-free to 1-800-447-4613.

We realize that providing this information may be a burden for your company. Consequently, we have only requested company data that are readily available in your books. To make complying with this federal requirement easier, we will accept estimates when book figures are not available.

Your response is required by law. Title 13, United States Code, requires businesses and other organizations that receive this questionnaire to answer the questions and return the report to the Census Bureau. Title 13 also assures **your report is confidential**. It may be seen only by persons sworn to uphold the confidentiality of Census Bureau information. Your information is used only to develop summary data that do not reveal the individual activities of your company. Under the same law, information cannot be used for taxation, regulation or investigation.
