



THIRD REQUEST

FROM THE U.S. CENSUS BUREAU

Two months ago we sent you an Annual Accommodation or Food Services Report form. We have made repeated attempts to obtain your firm's data by mail and still have not received your response. Your company's participation is vital to the success of this survey.

Your response is required by law. Title 13, United States Code, requires businesses and other organizations that receive this questionnaire to answer the questions and return the report to the Census Bureau. By the same law, **your report is confidential.** It may be seen only by persons sworn to uphold the confidentiality of Census Bureau information. Your information is used only to develop summary data that do not reveal the individual activities of your company. Under the same law, information cannot be used for taxation, regulation or investigation.

You continued failure to respond opens your business enterprise and responsible officials to public prosecution and civil penalties. To remove your firm from delinquent status, we ask that you take the time to complete the enclosed form and **return it within the next three business days.** Once you have completed the form, you may fax it toll-free to 1-800-447-4613. If you wish to report online using our secure Web site, your username and password as well as the Web site address are located on the form beneath the address label. Representatives from the Census Bureau will contact you by telephone if necessary to obtain your firm's data. Phone calls may be monitored to evaluate interviewer performance.
