Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is the source of CBP data?**

CBP data are extracted from the Business Register, the Census Bureau's file of all known single and multiestablishment companies. Data comes from a variety of sources, including the Economic Censuses, the Annual Survey of Manufactures, and Current Business Surveys, as well as from administrative records of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), the Social Security Administration (SSA), and the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS).

- **Are sales and receipts data provided in CBP?**

No. Sales and receipts data are available from other Census Bureau programs. For more information, please see the Census Bureau's economic data.

- **I need specific data for company X:**

The U.S. Census Bureau is forbidden by Federal Law from providing data that can be linked to specific employers.

- **Time Series Data:**

Due to changes in methodology, county definitions, and classification codes over time, there is currently no way to batch download multiple years of data. However, Census is developing a new database tool to accommodate these issues, due for release by the 2017 Economic Census.



Definitions

- **Legal Form of Organization (LFO)** – An LFO is the organizational structure a firm chooses to adopt.
- **North America Industry Classification System (NAICS)** – The standard used by Federal statistical agencies in classifying business establishments. For more information, visit the NAICS website: <https://www.census.gov/eos/www/naics>
- **Noise Infusion** – A method of disclosure avoidance in which values for each firm are perturbed prior to the data being released. Read more on the [How the Data Are Collected](#) page.
- **NOISE Flags**–
 - G - Low Noise Infusion
 - H - Medium Noise Infusion
 - J - High Noise Infusion
 - D - Withheld to avoid disclosing data for individual companies; data are included in higher level totals
 - S – Withheld because estimate did not meet publication standards
- **Statewide** – Classification for employees in a state without a fixed location.



This data is useful for studying the economic activity of small areas; analyzing economic changes over time; and as a benchmark for other statistical series, surveys, and databases between economic censuses. Businesses use the data for analyzing market potential, measuring the effectiveness of sales and advertising programs, setting sales quotas, and developing budgets. Government agencies use the data for administration and planning.

Data User Notice posted on July 21, 2016: Census Bureau staff identified a processing error that affects selected data from the 2014 County Business Patterns (CBP) and 2014 ZIP Code Business Patterns (ZBP). As a result, we suppressed 2014 employment and payroll totals in the Health Care and Social Assistance sector (Sector 62) for the following geographies: U.S.; Michigan; Battle Creek, MI metro area; Calhoun County, MI; the 3rd congressional district of Michigan; and ZIP code 49015. This processing error did not affect other sectors. While suppressed values can be derived by subtraction, we do not recommend using the derived values in any analyses. The Census Bureau plans to release revised statistics at a later date.
