

Accomplishments since the January 2015 Program Management Review:

- Reorganization package submitted to Human Resources Division (HRD)
- Decennial management trained on the RACI (Responsible, Accountable, Consulted, Informed) tables and concepts of operations documents for the new divisions and offices
- On schedule for a spring implementation
