PART 2 - REVENUES

3. A. Property taxes (code T01)

Exclude

- Property taxes collected for the county and school districts
- For towns, state payments made under the Land Use Appraisal Program (property tax relief) (*report in PART 2, question 4, item L., "General support (unrestricted)", code C30*)

3. C. Licensing and permit taxes

2. Amusement licensing and permit taxes (code T21)

Include

- Proceeds from licenses and permits issued to theaters, shows, movies, concert halls, natural curiosities, and auto races
- Other amusements for which licensing is required

3. Motor vehicles licensing and permit taxes (code T24)

Include

- Administrative fees retained by this city, village, or town for renewal of car registration

4. Public utilities licensing and permit taxes (code T27)

Include

- Administrative fees retained by this city, village, or town for renewal of bus and taxicab registration

3. E. Other taxes

2. Documentary and stock transfer tax (code T51)

Include

- Clerk's fees collected for property tax transfer returns

4. Intergovernmental revenues

N. All other (codes D89, C89, B89)

Include

- Other grants and reimbursements from other local governments, State and Federal

PART 3 - EXPENDITURES

11. Personnel expenditures (code Z00)

Include

- Salaries and wages for all employees, full-time and part-time
- Salaries paid for employees of any utility owned and operated by this government
- Salaries in gross amount before deductions for income taxes, social security, or retirement coverage

Exclude

- Employer-paid fringe benefits and payroll taxes

PART 4 – INDEBTEDNESS

12. Long-term debt

A. Debt for public purposes

Include

- Debt that originates from the purchase of bonds of this government by the Vermont Municipal Bond Bank

B. Debt for private purposes

Include

- Industrial revenue and pollution control bonds issued by this government

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
