The key for RACE\_HISP is as follows:

0 = Total population

1 = White alone

2 = Black alone

3 = AIAN alone

4 = Asian alone

5 = NHPI alone

6 = Two or More Races

7 = Not Hispanic

8 = Hispanic

9 = Non-Hispanic White alone

The key for SEX code is as follows:

0 = Both sexes

1 = Male

2 = Female

NOTE: Hispanic origin is considered an ethnicity, not a race. Hispanics may be of any race.

ABBREVIATIONS: Black = Black or African American; AIAN = American Indian and Alaska Native; NHPI = Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander
