YEAR	Year of projection (2014 to 2060)
(ASDR_0, ASDR_1, ..., ASDR_99, ASDR_100)	Age-specific death rate

The key for GROUP is as follows:

- 1 = Non-Hispanic White or non-Hispanic API
- 2 = Non-Hispanic Black or non-Hispanic AIAN
- 3 = Hispanic

The key for SEX is as follows:

- 1 = Male
- 2 = Female

NOTE: Hispanic origin is considered an ethnicity, not a race. Hispanics may be of any race. The age-specific death rate in a given year is equal to the total number of deaths occurring between July 1 of the preceding year and June 30 of the indicated year, divided by the population on January 1 of the indicated year.

ABBREVIATIONS: Black = Black or African American; AIAN = American Indian and Alaska Native; API = Asian and Other Pacific Islander
