

## 2000 Health Insurance Coverage Status by Age for Counties and States: State File Record Layout

1-2	FIPS state code (00 for U.S. record)
4-5	Postal state abbreviation
7-31	State name
33-42	Number of insured all ages
44-53	Number of uninsured all ages
55-64	90% confidence interval of number insured/uninsured all ages ( $\pm$ )
66-69	Percent of uninsured all ages
71-74	90% confidence interval of percent uninsured all ages ( $\pm$ )
76-85	Number of insured under age 18
87-96	Number of uninsured under age 18
98-107	90% confidence interval of number insured/uninsured under age 18 ( $\pm$ )
109-112	Percent of uninsured under age 18
114-117	90% confidence interval of percent uninsured under age 18 ( $\pm$ )
119-149	File name and creation date

### Notes:

- The width of the confidence intervals for the number insured and the number uninsured are the same. This follows from the fact that the two numbers must add to a known population. A random deviation in one must thus be mirrored exactly in the other, so a measure of variability like the standard deviation must be the same.
- Due to rounding, the sum of the state estimates may not equal the national estimate from the Annual Social and Economic Supplement of the Current Population Survey.
