Starting with the September 2010 release, estimated measures of sampling variability correspond to the particular quarterly estimates. In prior releases, measures of sampling variability were medians based on estimates for the most recent four quarters. To compute a median comparable to what was previously published, identify the sampling variance measure of interest for the most recent four quarters. Sort the four quarterly sampling variance measures in ascending order.
